

Texas Scramble - No Gimmies Allowed

The player whose best drive is used cannot hit a second shot. Unless it's to putt on a par 3.

- Enter the names of the players on your score card.
- The 80% handicap rule is used. We will calculate it.
- All teams must use at least 4 tee shots from each player, including the designated 4th man on 3 man teams.
- After the tee shot, play is to be continued according to regular scramble format for players using the best shot until the team has holed out.
- Players can move the ball one club length on the fairway, or one putter head width on the green, or 12 inches in a bunker to improve the lie, but no closer to the hole
- Record your gross team score on the bottom half of your score card and turn it in to Vern or Andrew at the end of the round.
- Mark an X to indicate whose tee shot was used.
- **WE WILL CALCULATE THE WINNING SCORES.**
- If you need clarification of the rules see Vern Novack or Andrew Connaris

3 Man Teams

- The #4 spot is to be used as the phantom player.
- Must take turns in a pre-determined rotation to hit a tee shot as the 4th man
- Players must hit in a manner to ensure the phantom player does not hit or putt 2 shots consecutively.
