Gift Aid Donations for 2018/19 - There are a few Gift Aid boxes for 2018/19 to be collected from the back of church. The reason is, the boxes include the envelopes for the special collections, which also qualify for tax refunds to the Parish equal to 25% of the amount contributed. However, if any donors would prefer not to be issued with a box, will they please inform Jack Hayhurst. Payments to the Parish collections by monthly standing order are particularly welcomed and offer the benefit of convenience and the continuation of payment at such times as holiday absence from the Sunday Masses. They also reduce the work of the volunteers who count and bank the collection monies. We would welcome any new volunteers to assist with the task of counting and banking the collection monies received at Mass.
