- A cover letter, signed by the nominator;
- A completed Nomination Form;
- The nominee's curricula vitae or biographical information;
- A recent color photograph of the nominee, head-and-shoulders shot; and
- Letters of reference with contact information are desired, but not required (maximum of three).

## Other Information:

- The nominee must have more than 8 years of engineering experience and more than 4 of those years must be post PE certification.
- The nominee must reside within the section boundaries. A map of the section boundaries is attached for reference.
- The entire nomination package shall not exceed 10 pages.
- Electronic submittals are acceptable, but please confirm that they have been received.
- Submittals should be a PDF format that readily allows transfer of the nomination content to other documents for the purpose of evaluation and presenting nominee merits in a Section Newsletter.
