

Feast of Apparition of the Holy Cross



The pinnacle of every Christian's spirituality is in the Victorious Resurrection of Christ, our Lord, an event which has revolutionized the course of history and has woven into the fabric of society the spirit of rebirth and the breath of new faith. Through God's Resurrection, the image of the Almighty God, which had been stained by sin, has been rekindled in the heart of humanity. In his message to the Corinthians, St. Paul, the Apostle, reflects on the power and the glory of God. "But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." The Apostle's message delivered in the first century applies to each of us today, for we too, must nourish our souls by reviving Christ's Victorious Resurrection in our hearts.

As the Great Lent concludes, let us reflect on the impact of the spiritual journey. We prayed, fasted, and engaged in God-pleasing deeds through almsgiving. What we gained in the process is the spiritual strength to greet our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ in His triumphant entry into Jerusalem. From exclaiming "Hosanna" to proclaiming "He is Risen," we have become the living testimony of the Resurrection of Christ, our Lord. Today, along with the myrrh-bearing women, we proudly announce the greatest news in history:

"Christ is Risen from the Dead!"

Blassted is the Resurrection of Christ!"

Christ's Resurrection draws us closer to God, requiring from us the commitment to lead a Christ-like life. In doing so, we continue to be engaged in fervent prayer, we renounce the sinful life and hence, the self-alienation from God. Those whose hearts are filled with the mystery of the Resurrection express it purely through a God-pleasing lifestyle.

Undoubtedly, man, in essence, is sinful. However, as spiritual beings, we are able to reignite the spark of spirituality to elevate our lives to God thus, transforming the course of our lives.

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This feast is dedicated to the Apparition of the Holy Cross in Jerusalem. At noon on May 19, 351, a bright, luminous cross appeared over the skies of Jerusalem, centred over an area spanning from the Mount of Olives (where Christ was betrayed and arrested) to Golgotha (where Christ was crucified). Awe struck, the faithful of Jerusalem rush to church to give thanks and glorify the Lord. Bishop Cyril (later St. Cyril of Jerusalem) subsequently wrote a letter to Emperor Constantine of Byzantium wherein he describes the miraculous and beautiful scene. St. Cyril tells Constantine that the apparition is a true testimony of the orthodox faith of Christianity. Further, St. Cyril exhorts the Emperor that the appearance is a sign for him to remain steadfast in his faith, and to stop defending the heretical movement of Arianism and its promoters. The Armenian Church celebrates this feast 28 days following Easter Sunday.

On Easter Sunday, we celebrate the Feast of victory over death. The journey of our nation is similar to that of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ carrying His cross on the path to Golgotha. However, what seemed to be a woe full path for the Son of God, became a sign of victory. The lives of our martyred ancestors became victorious ones as well. To us as Christian Armenians, the church, the Motherland, our Christian Land, our spiritual values, the school and the sanctity of the family are divine gifts of God blessed by all in the depth of our hearts.

May the Victorious Resurrection of Christ, become the revelation of God's power and glory in our lives.

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

For the next fifty days we will celebrate Glorious Resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. As Christians we are supposed to rejoice and be glad about this annunciation which God wants to share with us.

Nor Gragj (New Sunday), Ashgharamatan (Church Sunday), Garmiti Gragj (Red Sunday), etc. During

these days Christians triumphantly presence is accompanying us to the eternal journey of His heavenly

kingdom.

Fifty days after the Resurrection we are always eyewitnesses of His Almighty Ascension, which happens

as our Lord promised His faithful people. And finally, ten days after our Lord's Glorious Ascension, the

Holy Spirit descends upon believers and distributes for them the divine graces.

As the church hymn says: "The eternal and uncreated Being, same in essence and inseparable from the


Son, (the co-creator) the Holy Spirit today is distributed among the apostles as tongues of fire, he draws
