**MARCHERS COVERING KONA IN PRAYER AND SHARING THE WORD:** from 9am to 10am, park and meet at the PUBLIC PARKING area located on Kuakini Hwy between Palani and Henry streets on the Makai side of the road. You will receive your Prayer March T-shirts that you can personalize. If you wish, you can take Bibles and tracts to be given away on your route, and signs will be available to carry. Bring a light backpack or bag to carry your supply. Bottled water will be available for you also. Depending on numbers, you can go in groups on different routes or all together as one. Ultimately, all to gather at the gathering place on Hwy 11 south of Henry (as described below).

**NON-MARCHING PRAYER WARRIORS:** by 10am, meet at our gathering place on the makai side of Highway 11, south of Henry Street where you see rallies and local vendors regularly. If you plan to sit, please bring your own folding chairs. As long as you can pull off the highway you can park there. Be sure to leave room for walkers. You will receive your Prayer March T-shirts. We are going to try to set up a “Pull in for Prayer” or the “Pule Pull-in” area for the passing vehicles. Signs and flags will be available to wave. A supply of Bibles will be available to give away.

## **THINGS TO REMEMBER:**

STAY hydrated, water bottles will be provided – Port-a-Potties too at the gathering place!

WEAR MASKS, DISTANCE AND ABIDE BY THE COVID RULES so as not to bring condemnation to the message we carry.

DO NOT impede traffic in any way. Please stay on the sidewalks or side of highway, inside the white line.

PRAY aloud or in silence – no need for me to tell you what to pray for, there’s plenty to choose from!

SING, those with instruments that can travel, bring along. Those others can do so at the gathering spot. Music draws people with their hearts.

SHARE this information with others, bring your friends/family along – saved and unsaved!
