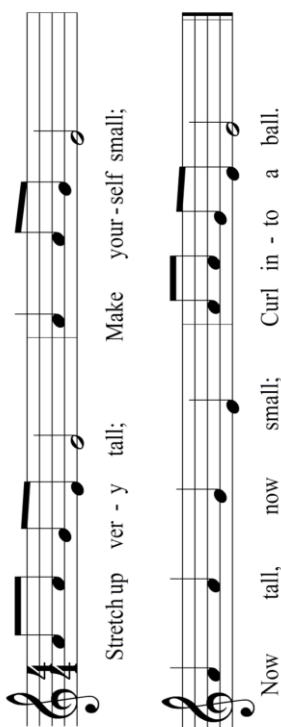



I picked up my fry-in pan.

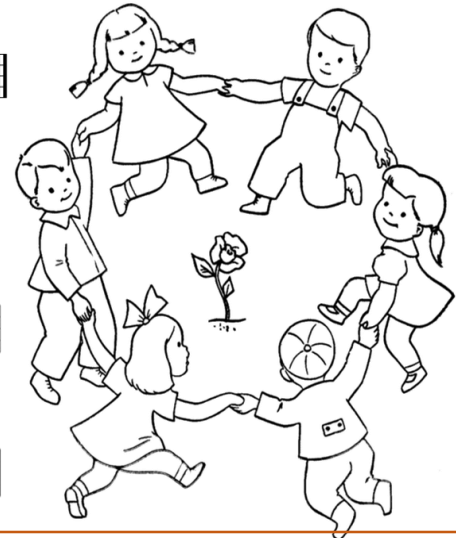
Twen - ty four rob-bers at my door, Step back ba-by, step back.


Sometimes my mommy takes me over to another friend's house to play.
