Every Sunday is the Lord's Day, the day of the Resurrection, and the nature of it should define how we live the rest of our lives – to walk in newness of life. So whether that's moving from gathered worship to a small group (for discipleship) or moving from a small group to a ministry of service (possibly for Outreach), wherever God is calling you, let the reality of Easter take you beyond the confines of where you are now – from the tomb to the calling you have through the Spirit. – *Pastor Brian*

### <u>A Devotional For You</u> – Read John 19:10-19, 25-27

Many of you know that this month I will be going on a Holy Land pilgrimage tour to Israel. I not only want to ask for your prayers for our group and its travels, but that I and the others going grow in our faith and experience God's Word through "closer contact" to the geography and history of God's redemptive work in that special part of the world – especially in the places touched by his incarnation in Jesus. Walking in the land of the Bible, seeing the places where the events took place, understanding more clearly the 3-dimensional environment in which history's most significant happenings occurred – it will be hard to process, but suffice it to say I'm excited. One of the places I'm most interested to see is the Via Dolorosa – the path Christ took from the city of Jerusalem to the hill of Calvary. Since Good Friday is only a few days away, when we remember all that Christ went through leading up to his death, that path has been on my mind a lot lately. But I've also prepared myself to 'not set expectations' - because I hear the actual path is different than you might expect – it's actually quite "tame." Yes, there will be other groups of pilgrims, carrying crosses and singing hymns quietly, offering prayers at the Stations of the Cross, but I'm told it can feel very sterile or ceremonial. It can be quiet, and hushed, but it can also feel "wrong" because when Jesus trod the Via Dolorosa ("Way of Suffering"), it wasn't polite or worshipful. It was violent, hate-filled, noisy and bloody. By the way, I've read that the "actual" path Jesus trod is underneath about 20 feet underground – buried beneath 2,000 years of history piling onto the old city. There's a lesson there too about how 'deep' we have to go to find the 'real thing.'

I suppose the point of my devotional is to be careful with the "expectations" of what comes out of our "devotional intentions" ... sometimes we may think that coming to Christ in prayer and devotion will be an encouraging and uplifting experience – and many times it is! But sometimes that uplifting feels more like what Jesus did for his mother while he was on the cross. He lets us see with our eyes the things we love being crushed ... but also puts us in the care of those he has equipped (he put Mary into the tender care of the Apostle John). But remember, before we hear the words, "Behold your son ... behold your mother" ... or even "Father, forgive them" ... being with Jesus may mean walking a "way of suffering" ... having the decorum of our lives disrupted, so we can see the real path underneath. Only when we look at the bleeding portrait of the strength of Christ's deity in the humbleness of that path, will we see the majesty of his grace. With all that in mind, I will try to "see" with the right eyes when I get to Jerusalem, and I pray that you also watch, not as a spectator in the crowd, but with the eyes of faith. May your Holy Week be *full* ... full of contemplation, full of reverence, full of prayer, and full of hope.
