It's time to begin preparing for next year's CM season. Remember that it is your responsibility to keep yourself informed!! The following is required reading for a successful CM, for you and your students: *2015-16 Policies and Procedures* (online at mtac.org), the current CM Syllabus for your instrument, Branch and State newsletters, all communication from the CM Council, and any emails from me regarding CM. Please don't hesitate to contact me at ellen.m.noble@gmail.com with any questions or concerns. I am looking forward to seeing everyone at our potluck/CM meeting.

Mandatory CM Information Meeting: I will email every member of MTACLB the 2015-16 CM Questionnaire early in September in preparation for our information meeting. Complete the questionnaire and bring it with you to the meeting or mail it to me by Sept. 28. You will not be allowed to enroll students in CM if I have not received your questionnaire by this date.

New this year:

The branch fee per student is increased to \$12.00. The reason for this increase is to cover branch CM expenses because the State will no longer be sharing the CM registration fee with the branches.
Teachers with more than 3 students will not be allowed to request the same day for their entire studio.
