SAFETY ORTS:

Safety class/Renewals:

Safety classes are required for ALL membership renewals. Classes for next year's renewals have begun. There will be multiple opportunities to attend a safety class both following the regular club meetings and at other scheduled times, to be announced. A safety class is required for each year. There will be no more membership renewals until March at the regular renewal time. New members will be allowed to join through January at the pro-rated price of \$70. No new members will be accepted in February.

EVENTS:

Gun Law Seminar:

Texas Law Shield will be offering a class on current and new gun laws at the club on December 3rd from from 6:00PM to 8:00PM at the TPPC classroom. Class is open to the public, members are encouraged to bring a guest. The cost of the class is \$5 for Texas Law Shield members and \$10 for non-members. LTC and IDPA

If you attend 6 maintenance nights, you will get \$25 off your annual dues. Member Renewals

Membership renewal is moving from December to March for next year's renewals. This change is to allow renewals to happen when members might have fewer activities and more available cash. Your current membership will be extended through March at no extra charge. Meeting attendance for the gun drawing for this year will still be cutoff in December and the drawing will occur in January. The gun drawing for the following year will be held in April.

Citizens Police Academy

Sgt. Mickey Blackmon from PCSO informed club members about their citizens policy academy held each year. They have one for youth and one for adults. It is a 12-week program designed to familiarize citizens of Potter County with goals, objectives, organizational structure and general operating procedures of PCSO. (You do not have to be a resident of Potter County to attend). The adult academy is held in September. There is no charge. Spots are limited.
