- Update on Covid-19 was given. To date: 808 confirmed cases and 14 deaths in Clinton County. The Chief Judge has suspended all jury trials.
- County budget is complete.
- Washburn is up for re-election on November 3rd.

- George moved to transfer \$7500 from the general account to the tax account to avoid service charges, supported by Gavenda. MPC.
- December newsletter discussed. Ideas include Clinton Area Transit millage, cemetery clean up, cemetery manager, and new firefighter hire.
- Gavenda moved to accept the treasurer's report, supported by Winsor. MPC.

Clerk's Report:

- Year to date budget was reviewed.
- Conner moved to reallocate \$800 from account 941: Contingency to account 215-970: Clerk Capital Outlay, supported Winsor. MPC.
- Conner moved to reallocate \$1000 from account 671: Other Revenue to account 262-752: Election Supplies and \$1000 from account 671: Other Revenue to account 262-971: Elections Capital Outlay, supported by George. MPC.
- Conner moved to reallocate \$1100 from account 941: Contingency to account 449-959: Public Works Brine, supported by George. MPC.
- Election update was given. 430 absentee ballots have been sent and approximately 300 returned. A \$5000 grant was received to cover election expenses related to Covid-19 and absentee voting.
- Damaged trees were cut and removed from cemeteries due to storm damage. Insurance reimbursed township \$700 from the June 3rd storm and \$2762.50 from the June 10th storm.
