



UCC GENERAL SYNOD

General Synod 34, the biannual gathering of the United Church of Christ, was held June 30-July 4 in Indianapolis with the theme "Making All Things New." Delegates from all 36 Conferences of the UCC gathered for worship, business meetings to vote on numerous resolutions, workshops, and other events. Two items of note, in particular, with regard to the results of this gathering:

- Rev. Karen Georgia Thompson was elected as the first black woman to lead the denomination as General Minister and President. She succeeds Rev. John Dorhauer, who has served for the past eight years.
- A series of Bylaw changes was approved that will cause General Synod to take place every three years, instead of every two. The vote needed a two-thirds majority of the 686 delegates and passed by a margin of one.
