



"THE FRAGRANCE OF CHRIST"

This is the time of year when we are seeing, hearing, and smelling those things that bring to our remembrance past good times. We may see a particular decoration that reminds us of our early years at home. We may hear a song that we sang together as a favorite each holiday season. We may smell the fragrance of evergreen that reminds us of our fresh-cut tree as a child.

We enjoy many wonderful scents through candles, burner melts, and diffusers. The apostle Paul so beautifully words a different type of fragrance in 2 Cor. 2:14 (NKJV), "*Now thanks be to God who always leads us in triumph in Christ, and <u>through us diffuses the fragrance of His</u> <i>knowledge in every place.*" As Christians, the knowledge of God should be in our minds AND working through our lives. Verse 15 says, "*For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing.*" Yes, we are to be the fragrance of Christ every day and everywhere we go, but even at best, everyone will not be touched, or changed, by this fragrance.

Paul continues, "*To one <u>we are the aroma</u> of death leading to death, and to the other the aroma of life leading to life*" (2 Cor. 2:16). Those who reject Christ are dead in sin and will remain lost. Those who believe will have the abundant life here (Jn. 10:10), and eternal life in heaven.

Though many will reject the savor of Christ, we can never stop diffusing His fragrance.
