

Recommendations to Eagle Landing HOA

11/15/16

1. Continue process of gar and small bass removal.
 - a. Schedule 1 additional 5 hour electrofishing session.
 - b. Temporarily revise bass bag and slot limits.
 - i. Keep all bass 14" and under.
 - ii. No bag limit on bass.
2. Do not proceed with addition of lime at this time.
 - a. Continue to monitor pH and other properties of lake through fall/winter.
3. Research safe and economical methods to add fish structure to lake.
4. Encourage homeowners to feed baitfish around their dock.
 - a. Floating fish food containing at least 25 percent protein should be used.
 - b. Do not over-feed the fish.
 - c. Discontinue feeding if the water temperature is lower than 50 degrees or greater than 85 degrees.
 - d. Feed fish once a day five to seven times a week to maintain maximum growth.
 - e. Feed fish the same time each day. Feeding bluegill during the evening is suggested.
 - f. Feed fish in the same place every day with the use of feeding rings.
 - g. Lochow Ranch and websearch recommends Purina aquamax carnivorous 500
 - i. \$42.50 per 50 lb, at Jakes. Should be lower \$/feeding.
 - ii. \$41.89 per 81 lb through Amazon.
 - iii. LR will also sell us their brand by pallet.
5. Run pilot test for treatment of Water Snowflake.
 - a. Detailed observation shows little growth of infestation.
 - b. Green pads are turning slightly brown
 - c. Recruit volunteer for small, isolated patch to be treated.
6. Communications for community.
 - a. Publish initial survey results on websight.
 - b. Publish fish feeding info and electrofishing survey on NextDoor.
7. **Reminder** – Please use mono fishing line recycle bin at dam ramp.
