

The Music of Elmo Wick: *Fiddle Tunes of Crow River Country*

This tune book is the outcome of a year-long project to transcribe fiddle tunes from rural Minnesota collected by fiddler and music historian Elmo Wick. Mr. Wick was born in 1924 and raised in Sunburg, MN learning the fiddle from his father, grandfather and uncles at an early age. In retirement, Elmo taught himself to write music and transcribed fiddle tunes that were played in Minnesota in 1880's through the 1920's. Elmo donated his handwritten tune collection to Minnesota State Fiddlers Association (MSFA) before he passed away in 2009. This 44-page book includes 35 heirloom Minnesota fiddle tunes and chords with stories and pictures from the fiddlers who played them.
