Classroom Newsletters

This year the teachers asked to do Classroom Newsletters, and the Lead Teachers will provide you with a Classroom Newsletter each month. Ms. Andrea will write the newsletter for Classroom A. For Classroom B the teachers will alternate between Ms. Stegeman and Ms. Yered. In the class newsletters, the teachers will cover topics they are studying in the classroom along with what activities and lessons the class is working on. The dynamics of each classroom is a little different, due to the children's individual needs. The teachers gauge the needs of the students as they set up their classrooms. Additionally, classrooms can be a little bit different in what children are interested in learning.

Bi Weeklies

Last week the first bi-weekly report were sent home. The bi-weeklies give you more insight into what your child is doing in the classroom and with whom they are working and playing during class and recess time. Bi-weeklies typically continue all year, but often after the last Progress Report in April, some parents opt to no longer receive one. At the Spring Progress Report, you will be asked whether or not you would like to continue receiving a bi-weekly report on your child. If you do, then these will continue to be sent to you until the end of the school year. If you have any questions or comments about your child's progress, there is a space at the bottom of the bi-weekly to write comments, questions or concerns. Please sign and return the bi-weekly report to your child's Lead Teacher as soon as you can. If you would like a copy of your child's bi-weekly, just let the teachers know and they will provide one for you. Thank you.
