STANDARDIZED TESTING: Baseline/start of the year standardized testing for grades 2-8 began this week. As an ADW school, we use <u>MAP (Measures of Academic Progress)</u> computerized adaptive assessment, which measures students' knowledge in reading, language use, and math. This week the testing is for Reading, next week is Math, and the following week is Language Usage. Parents will receive a printout of their child's scores when testing is complete.
