

Mesquite Cemetery

Mesquite Cemetery is located on Highway 436, 2.6 miles east of IH-35 and Belton. Mesquite school was at the same site as the cemetery. Charles and Catherine Rabroker of Belton owned the land where the cemetery is located when data from the markers was taken on January 26, 2006 by Michael W. and Nancy Graff Kelsey. Personal information about the deceased follows the marker data.

The Hiram and Susan Fulton family was from Tennessee. Children in the family were Ella K., Willie Charles, Martha, Hiram, Johnnie, George G., and Eugene Fulton. Eugene Fulton moved to Parsons, Kansas. After Hiram's death Susan managed the farm and paid off their debts. They owned 105 acres and they grew cotton and wheat. They owned 18 horses and raised hogs and cattle. The Fulton family lived west of Elm Grove road.

Miss Kate V. Fulton

Kate Virginia Fulton was born in Tennessee October 28, 1896 and moved to Bell County as a child. She attended Prairie View College. She taught school and was a member of the Bethel AME Church in Belton where she lived at 315 South Davis Street. She died in Killeen April 12, 1966.

Susie M. Fulton lived on Route 2, Belton. She was the daughter of Sterling Wright and Mariah Wishic. Her cause of death was "very old and senile."

Elzo Holcomb lived at Troy. He was the son of Sam and Elvie Holcomb. His cause of death was CHF.

Martha Warren Oct 22, 1823 Sept 24, 1924

She was a native of Lincoln County, Tennessee.

She died at Three Forks of tuberculosis at age 55.

Hiram A. Fulton Oct 5, 1881 Mar 29, 1956

Hiram Arthur Fulton lived six miles southeast of Belton. He was the son of Hiram Fulton and Susie Gillispie. His death was caused by cancer of the prostate.

Ella K. Fulton July 18, 1875 Oct 28, 1952

Ella Kinkaid Fulton was the daughter of Hiram Fulton and Susan Gillispie. She was born in Fayetteville, Tennessee. She died of pulmonary tuberculosis. Mrs. James Thompson was her daughter.

Miss Willie Charles Fulton Apr 29, 1877 Jan 6, 1960

Willie Charles Fulton was born in Lincoln County, Tennessee. She was a hairdresser.

Annie M. Fulton May 24, 1863 Feb 11, 1891

The following are reported buried at Mesquite Cemetery but markers were not found.

Jim Morwel died at age 40 on April 13, 1922. A native of Washington County, he was the son of Jim Morwel and Laura Bank Morwel. He was a farm laborer.

Adam Williams was a farmer. He died from a stroke at age 60 on December 2, 1926.

Richard Thompson Powers, born December 9, 1926, was the son of Richard Powers and Annabelle Thompson Powers. He died April 5, 1927.

Howard White, born March 3, 1914, was the son of Rufus White and Berdia Lee Dykes White. He died April 19, 1938 from tuberculosis.

Roy L. Williams was born and died on January 26, 1939. He was the son of Roy Williams and Alice Pollard Williams.

L. V. Knight was born February 19, 1942 and died February 20, 1942. The parents were Dave Knight, born at Salado, and Tina Mae Powers Knight, born at Holland.
