Missouri is one of the few Midwestern states that still permit County Commissioners and County Health Boards to regulate CAFOs. In fact, all 8 states contiguous to Missouri prohibit local control of factory farms. As a result, large corporate agricultural entities have poured more money into the coffers of Missouri state legislators than in any other state legislature in the country. Subsequently, legislation is introduced every year to deny counties the authority to regulate CAFOs. Missouri has become Ground Zero for Corporate Agriculture.
