

2017 Poster Contest Rules and Guidelines Sponsored by Fulton County Soil and Water Conservation District

Open to grades 6th, 7th and 8th

- Any media may be used to create a flat or two dimensional effect (paint, crayon, colored pencil, charcoal, stickers, paper, or other material on regular posters)
- Poster size must be between 8.5"x 11" and 22"x28"
- A completed entry form must be attached to the back of the poster to make it eligible for judging
- Posters should be packaged so they remain flat when sent for judging.
- All posters must be created by individual student rather than a team of students and may not be traced from photographs or other artists' published works.
- The 2017 Stewardship title "Healthy Soils are Full of Life!" must be on your poster.
- Each entry to state contest must have been judged by the Fulton County SWCD prior to the state evaluation/contest.
- Only official state poster contest sponsors can mail for national contest.

Poster will be due March 31, 2017. Please call (770) 792-0594 ext. 100 or 101 to arrange for drop off or pick up of posters.

Prizes

First prize winners receive a cash reward in the amount of \$50; second place winners will receive \$35 and third will receive \$25. Additionally, \$50 will be awarded to the teacher with the most student poster submissions. Prizes in the poster contest categories are sponsored by the Fulton County Soil and Water Conservation District.
