



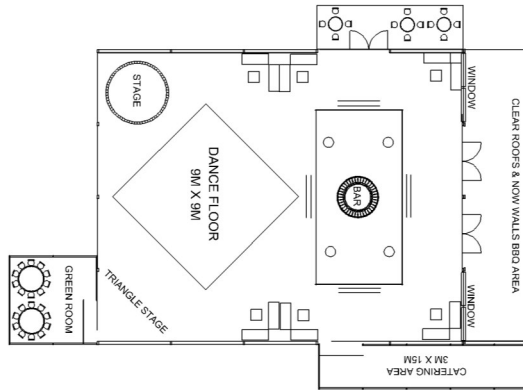
Case Study for High specification, build & finish for 250 Guests

The Venue:

Sited at the clients home, the venue featured a large, fairly level lawn, overlooking a lake, and a large thatched barn. The clients wanted to use the barn as an entrance to the marquee site.

Our Clients Wish List:

This event was a joint celebration for 50th, 21st and 18th birthdays. Using the barn as the arrival point for guests, the marquee was then positioned facing the open side to the barn. The overall look for the reception area was an Art Deco style with the circular bar as a central point for their guests. The younger clients requested a large dance floor area with a rather different look, providing plenty of seating, and common to both generations was the need for a comfortable outside area for smoking and the late night BBQ.



Marquee Design Summary:

In the bar / reception area the circular bar was installed on a raised platform accessed by four separate staircases, with glass balustrade surrounds. The time of year allowed us to make the most of lighting effects, so as well as central crystal chandelier over the bar—which also featured integral lighting we used a white flat lining and Gobo lights to scatter large Art Deco style flower patterns onto the linings. With no formal dining area, seating was provided by curved corner chesterfield sofas and low tables, high stools at the bar and tall poseur tables for those who preferred to stand. The dance area featured a white dance floor onto which a carousel of photographs were projected throughout the evening. The ceiling was lined with a stunning red star-cloth and as well as two stages occasional seating was provided with more seating. The outside decking area was protected by a clear roof, with views across the lake and glass balustrading for safety. The total cost was £25,700.00 incl VAT
