NOTICE OF A ROUTINE MONITORING VIOLATION FOR SWMOR

The City of Cisco, PWS ID TX0670001, has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public Water Systems that treat surface water and/or ground water under the direct influence of surface water are required to submit monthly operating reports with operational data of the treatment, disinfection and quality of the water provided to their customers.

These violation(s) occurred in the monitoring period August 2017.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe. We did not complete all monitoring and/or reporting for surface water constituents, and therefore TCEQ cannot be sure of the safety of your drinking water during that time.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

The reports were submitted to TCEQ, however, they were not submitted by the tenth day of the respective months as required by Title 30, Texas Administration Code (30 TAC). Although the reports were submitted in an untimely manner, all data provided to TCEQ was within normal limits for treated water. All employees have been informed of the deadline for submitting timely reports.
