## **General Rules & Information**

1. **RULES** – Western Style Dressage Association of Canada rules and tests are used at this competition. No qualifications required to enter this competition. Rules and tests available at <http://westernstyledressage.ca>
2. **SHOW OFFICE HOURS:**
  - a. Tuesday August 4<sup>th</sup> – 12:00pm – 5:00pm
  - b. Wednesday August 5<sup>th</sup> – 7:00am – 5:00pm
  - c. Thursday August 6<sup>th</sup> – Sunday August 9<sup>th</sup> – 7:00am – one hour after show ends
  - d. Monday August 10<sup>th</sup> – 7:00am – 12:00pm
  - e. After hour emergency number will be provided upon registration
3. **SHOW SCHEDULE** – Will be made available no later than July 29<sup>th</sup>, 2020 but may be subject to change up to the day before the show, which will be posted no later than 7:00pm.
4. **REQUIREMENTS** – Riders must have proof of current equine liability insurance upon entry.
5. **PETS:** All pets must be on a leash.
6. **WSDAC** – membership and horse registration required in order to submit to WSDAC for national point programs. WSDAC membership is NOT mandatory to enter the show.
7. **HELMETS** – WDIC & WSDAC strongly recommend the use of helmets during all rides.
8. **LOCATION** – Ancaster Fairgrounds located at 630 Trinity road S, Ancaster Ontario, Canada. Located corner of Wilson street and Trinity road. 3 mins south of HWY 52 and HWY 403 interchange.
9. **FOOD** - Food concession will be available. Additionally, many restaurants are located just 2 minutes east of the show grounds.
10. **SHOW RINGS** – Total of 3 competition rings. All outdoor weather arenas, with sand footing. 1 – 20m x 60m (used for Levels 1-4), 2 – 20m x 40m.
11. **SCHOOLING AREA**- Large warm up area with same footing adjacent to competition arenas. Lunging permitted only in designated areas and is prohibited in designated riding areas.
12. **STABLING** - Limited to 131 Permanent Stalls. Priority will be given to those competitors travelling the farthest distance. Should the stabling be filled, farms close within the proximity will have stabling available. Day stalls available if space permitted. The show grounds have 10'x10' permanent stalls with rubber floors. Shavings Available for \$10 per bag. Stalls must be stripped prior to departure, failure to do so will be billed \$50. Stalls will be assigned to you. Staff will be onsite 24/7.
13. **ACCOMODATION** – Host hotel is Holiday Inn Express & Suites located at 27 Sinclair Blvd, Brantford Ontario. Located 15 min West of the Fairgrounds. Reservation block is reserved under the Western Dressage International Championships. 1-855-516-1093. <http://hiexpress.com>

14. ENTRY FEE POLICY – All entry fees must be paid in full upon registering for the show. Stabling will be filled on a first come first serve basis other than the priorities listed above for out of province and distance travellers.
15. REFUNDS – No refund will be given without a valid medical / veterinary certificate. Refunds will be given less the administration costs of \$50 up to the day before the competition commences Thursday August 6<sup>th</sup>, 2020.
16. WAITING LIST - In the event that the show fills to capacity, there will be a waiting list and called upon in order of registration.
17. FREESTYLE – Musical Freestyle Sound Check will be done at 6:00pm the day before freestyle classes. All music MUST be in MP3 or approved format by show Co-ordinator.
18. AWARDS
  - a. Classes
    - i. Ribbons to 10<sup>th</sup> place in all classes.
    - ii. Winners of each class will also receive a suitable monetary prize.
    - iii. Any other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the show.
  - b. Divisional Championships
    - i. Champion and Reserve Ribbons awarded with suitable monetary prize.
    - ii. Ribbons 3<sup>rd</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> place.
    - iii. Average of 3 highest test scores at each level in each rider division.
  - c. Team Championships
    - i. See Attached Team competition detail page
    - ii. Team championships will receive Gold, Silver & Bronze medals.
  - d. In the event of a tie in the divisional championship, the combination with the highest single percentage will earn the tie breaker.
  - e. Presentation of awards; Class awards may be picked up at the WDIC show office. Division and team awards will be presented Sunday following the end of show.

1. Teams must submit a team name.
2. Riders who enter and do not have a team but wish to participate, please indicate on entry form.
3. All Riders that wish to be a part of a team and do not have a designated team will randomly be placed together to form a team.
