Des Moines Springfest Horse Show is governed by the rules of the Iowa Horse Shows Association. Qualifying classes will be governed by the organization sponsoring the class. Any rule not covered specifically by the IHSA will be interpreted by the USEF rule.

ENTRIES

Entries close April 12, 2019. All exhibitors are encouraged to make their entries by that date. Entries will be accepted at the regular rate up to April 12, 2019. After April 12, 2019, post entries will be accepted at the regular rate plus an additional \$10 per class. Entries are to be made on the official entry form. One owner per entry form. Send copies of registration papers, amateur cards, and pony measurement cards with entries. All fees must accompany entry form. Open checks may be established at the show.

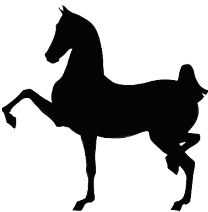

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

All horses must have current health papers issued within 30 days of the show. Out of state horses must have negative Coggins test dated within 12 months of show.

Des Moines Springfest Horse Show will abide by the USEF Equine Vaccination Rule GR845. Please review this rule at USEF.ORG

TRANSFERS, SUBSTITUTIONS, REFUNDS

The transfer of a horse and/or rider from one class to another will be allowed as follows: The show office must be notified prior to the affected classes. Horses may be switched to another class without penalty. Additional class entries will be charged a \$10.00 post entry fee. In the case of an injury, a veterinarian's certificate must be presented and entry fees, minus a \$25.00 office charge, will be refunded. Entries not officially scratched will be subject to a \$25.00 fine. Management reserves the right to split, combine or cancel classes.

STABLING

Stalls are available in the Iowa State Fairgrounds Main Horse Barn and auxiliary barns. All stalls have doors. Each horse entered is required to have a stall. No first bedding given. **Stalls available at 12:00 noon on Tuesday, April 23, 2019.**

End of Show: All horses and equipment must be removed from the premises **by 6 PM on Sunday, April 28, 2019.**

All Classics will offer \$250 premiums plus entry fees. Classic entry fees are divided into two payments: a **Declaration Fee** of \$50.00 is required with your entry form and the second payment, a **Starting Fee** of \$50.00, is required prior to the start of the session in which the class is held. You may pay the \$100.00 with your entry form if you wish. Classic fees are non-refundable in all situations. If April Nomination Fee has not been paid, a \$150 Nomination Fee must be paid in addition to the entry fee. Prize money is divided according to the rules set by the UPHA.

UPHA CHALLENGE CUP CLASSES

To be eligible to show in a UPHA Challenge Cup Class, each rider **must be a member of the UPHA.**

TRAINER CASH INCENTIVE PROGRAM

One Trainer's name will be drawn each session including the two Academy sessions. The name of the trainer of each entry showing in each session will be entered in a drawing. At the conclusion of each performance, one trainer's name will be drawn, and will win \$100. A new drawing is done each session; names do not carry over from previous sessions. The trainer's name will be obtained from the entry form. This program provides cash incentives, going directly to the trainers who support our show! **Trainer must be present at ringside when name is drawn to win.**

(Highway 163) Des Moines, Iowa**

FROM EASTERN IOWA

From I-80 westbound, take Exit 141, travel south on Hwy 65 to Exit 79, then go right (west) on Hwy 163 (University Avenue) approximately three miles to Fairgrounds. Turn left on East 30th, enter through Main Gate.

FROM WESTERN IOWA

From I-80 eastbound, take Hwy I-235. Stay on I-235 through downtown Des Moines and after crossing the Des Moines River, start looking for the East University exit. Take the East University exit, and follow University Ave. to East 30th Street. Turn right on East 30th to the Main Gate of the fairgrounds.

FROM NORTHERN IOWA

From I-35 southbound, continue going straight onto I-235. Take the East University exit, follow the signs to East University Ave. Turn left onto University Ave. and follow to East 30th Street. Turn right on East 30th to the Main Gate of the fairgrounds.

FROM SOUTHERN IOWA

From I-35 northbound, take the Des Moines freeway exit, I-235. Stay on I-235 through downtown Des Moines and after crossing the Des Moines River, start looking for the East University exit. Take the East University exit, and follow University Ave. to East 30th Street. Turn right on East 30th to the Main Gate of the fairgrounds.

Fairgrounds signs are posted on I-35 and I-80 and on the Des Moines freeway, I-235.

Livestock Facility Biosecurity

Biosecurity is a set of preventative measures designed to reduce the risks for introduction and transmission of an infectious disease agent.

The Iowa State Fair decontaminates and disinfects facilities used for livestock events. All cleaning and disinfection will be carried out so as to minimize or prevent the possible movement of diseases and pests on and off the fairgrounds premises. Disinfection will be carried out prior to every livestock event following the thorough cleaning of the previous event. The disinfectant product will be professionally applied by a company specializing in disease control in livestock facilities. Any participant in any livestock show that attempts to move into a facility before it has been properly disinfected; takes full responsibility for any and all disease that an animal may be exposed to, as well as any consequences that may lead to. The Iowa State Fair will to the best of our ability not allow entrance to any of our facilities until properly cleaned and disinfected.

Animal Health Examination Notification

All horses and other livestock that enter the grounds, whether entered in an event or not, are subject to examination by event officials and/or State

Animal Health Officials to determine whether such animals are, have been infected or exposed or are likely to be infected with an infectious or contagious disease. If after such examination, there is reason to believe an animal's health condition places other animals at risk, event officials may isolate such animal, and other animals that may have been infected or exposed. All participants agree to fully cooperate with event officials and abide by their decisions/instructions. Failing to comply shall be grounds for immediate expulsion of the participant from the grounds and potential disciplinary action by organization, local/state or federal animal health officials.
