We also want to make sure that you are aware of the many additional scholarship programs that we have available at St. Mary of the Assumption Catholic School that could help meet tuition needs. St. Mary of the Assumption Catholic School offers the following Tuition Assistance scholarships:

- 1. **The EdChoice Expansion Scholarship**: As an approved provider from the Ohio Department of Education any student entering kindergarten through third grade is eligible to have their tuition paid for by the State if their families income is at or below 200% of the federal poverty guidelines (example: a family of 4 with a Gross Annual Income of less than \$48,500 would be eligible).
- 2. St. Mary of the Assumption Catholic School Tuition Assistance Fund Scholarship: We have been blessed over the years to have many St. Mary of the Assumption Parish parishioners give donations to the school to be used toward helping families in need pay for tuition. The principal and pastor retain the authority to grant tuition assistance from this fund.
- 3. **The Richard Say Memorial Transfer Scholarship:** This scholarship is offered to any family who is transferring their child(ren) from a local school system to St. Mary's and are entering 1st through 5th Grade. This is a two year scholarship that is worth a total of \$1500.00, paying \$1000.00 the first year and \$500.00 in the second year.
- 4. Scrip: This program allows non-profit organizations like St. Mary's to purchase gift cards for most every-day expenses like food, clothing, fuel and entertainment. The cards, from most major vendors, can then be purchased from the parish/school. The school earns a percentage of the card's value from each purchase. A portion of that return can be credited toward a student's tuition. Since Scrip can be used for almost all, every-day expenses, everyone can participate in some way.
