Step back in time with a visit to Heritage Hall Museum and Archives! Our museum is overflowing with artifacts from the Germans from Russia who settled this community in the 1870s, while our Archives Library is filled with books, documents and photos from the lives they lived.

Artisans and “Heritage Pickers” will be on hand daily from 3-7 p.m., with demonstrations and stories of days gone by. Come see local crafts such as basket making, spinning, caning, rope making, tating and more. Come listen as our “Heritage Pickers” share 10-minute stories throughout the museum. Schedules are posted around campus.

Let history come to life as you step into a pioneer home built in 1879, check out tools and machines used by early farmers, admire the Waltner brothers’ 1927 bi-plane, take a seat in the old country school, or imagine a ride on one of our early motorcycles!

Throughout the day, we’ll be showing “Three Groups, One Story,” the recently-released movie about the Low German Mennonites, Swiss Amish, and Hutterite peoples who settled this area. Admittance to the film is included with museum admission. Copies are available for purchase at the Archives.

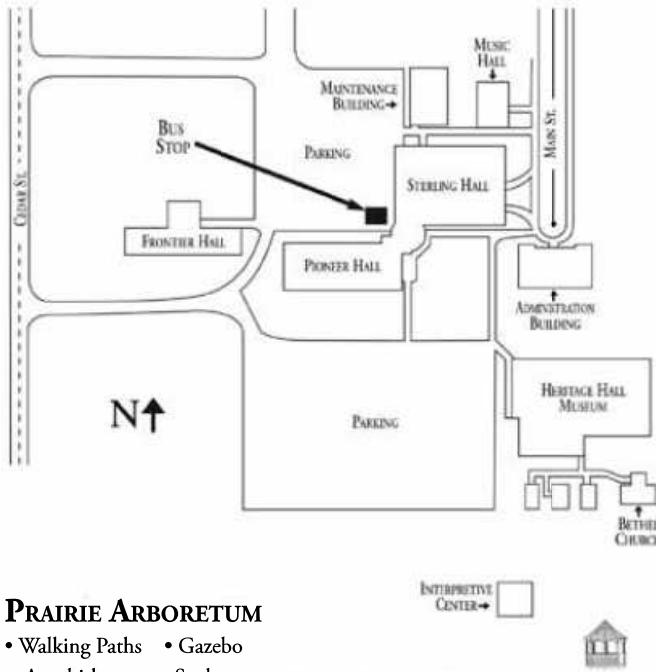
