Upcoming Tournaments (Online Tournament Calendar)

March 15th – President's Cup Qualifier/Individual Low Gross/Low Net March 29th – Individual Low Gross/Low Net

Our first major of the year will start on March 15th with the President's Cup Qualifier. The President's Cup is a handicapped match play tournament funded by the Men's Club. The low 32 players from the Qualifier will be seeded in a single elimination bracket. The following rules apply to the President's Cup:

- Members must have participated in at least one Men's Club tournament in 2015 prior to the President's Cup Qualifier

- All members will use their LI (Low Index) as of 3/15/15 for the duration of the tournament
- The first match after the Qualifier must be played by 3/29/15. All following matches must be played in consecutive weeks by Sunday. The final match should be completed by 4/26/15. Be aware that if you win your match, you may be playing every Sunday for five weeks.
- If members can't agree on a date and time to play their match, the default is Sunday at 8:00 am. If one or both members can't make Sunday at 8:00 am, the member or match is forfeited.
- If weather prohibits the play of a match on a Sunday, all matches will be postponed for one week
- All matches must be played at Calimesa Country Club from the white tees
- The member with the higher handicap gets the difference between his handicap and the lower handicapped member
- If the match ends in a tie, the match goes immediately into sudden death on the next hole and strokes are given based on the hole's handicap. If a match is played during a tournament and members start on hole # 13, sudden death starts on hole # 14.

Reminders

Please be diligent about turning in complete and legible scorecards during tournaments. Scorecards need to clearly show each member's last name. The scorecard must be signed by the scorer and attested by another member in the group. Scorecards that are not complete or legible will not be accepted. Don't get disqualified from a tournament because the Tournament Committee can't read your scorecard.

In case of dangerous weather, lighting, flooding, etc., during tournament play, members will continue to play until instructed to stop playing by the management of the golf course. In the absence of golf course management, the board present at the tournament will take a vote on the decision to stop play. An air horn will be sounded. Once play is stopped, members will mark their ball and return to the clubhouse for announcements. Members will return to their marked spot when play resumes and continue play until the round is completed. The date and time play resumes will be determined by the board. Any players that decide not to continue when play resumes or that cannot make the rescheduled date and time when play resumes will be disqualified from the tournament.ii
