# Here's an update on our move to Main

Welcome to the Trustees Corner. In this edition we would like to give you an update on the future home of Daffodil Aerie #2308. As most everyone is aware, Sound Transit has updated our lease agreement. Our new, and final, move out date is March 10. This is the final extension of our lease, as shortly thereafter, Sound Transit will begin their construction on the property. As part of the updated lease agreement, Daffodil #2308 agreed to turn over the parking lot on 3rd Avenue to Sound Transit for construction staging; in return they cut our lease payment in half.

Our new building construction continues with the new addition, which houses the bathrooms, being built. The bar equipment has been installed, the bar tops have been installed, a significant amount of painting is complete along with countless other small tasks. Our goal is to be ready for occupancy by the March 10 deadline, with a functioning bar, restrooms, and offices. Most likely the kitchen will not be complete, as we await large payments from Sound Transit to finish the purchase of the kitchen equipment. Until the kitchen is ready to open, we are exploring options of having external vendors, such as food

trucks, set up to serve food on a limited basis.

In an effort to save the Aerie construction costs, we will be looking for volunteers to help with the installation of the bar and restaurant flooring, insulation and sheetrock of the bathrooms, along with painting and cleanup. Messages will be sent out notifying members when the volunteers will be needed.

The Trustees would like to take this time to thank all of the volunteers who have helped with the new building. Your dedication and selfless donation of time and talents has not gone unnoticed and we would not be where we are without you!

The Trustees would like to encourage all members to attend Aerie and Auxiliary meetings. At the member meetings you can learn and understand how the Aerie and Auxiliary function, learn about the finances and business of the Aerie and Auxiliary, and maybe win a raffle or drawing.

As always, feel free to leave comments in the suggestion box. If there is a subject you would like to see written about, leave that as well in the suggestion box. Come to a meeting, be a part of the process. It's *your* Aerie, support it.
