Stainless Steel Kitchens Inc. manufactures stainless steel cabinets and countertops for residential, commercial and institutional use. Cabinets are available in two series: Architectural (all stainless) and Designer (stainless over Russian birch plywood). Both series are available in NSF and ADA configurations, and are available with a standard toekick or adjustable legs. All our countertops are made to our client's dimensions. We pride ourselves on the quality of design and premium materials used in our cabinets and countertops and our commitment to customer service. Our cabinets are proudly made in America and material is locally sourced.

We are located in the Chicago Metropolitan area, but ship throughout the continental United States, Hawaii, Alaska, and the Caribbean. Our customers include architects, contractors, interior designers, and individual homeowners, in projects such as fire stations, doctors' offices, demonstration kitchens, residential indoor and outdoor kitchens, and government facilities.

Our Stainless Steel Product Line

We offer premium quality cabinetry in 2 separate series to fit the needs of your project (Architectural and Designer Series). Cabinets in the Architectural Series are suitable for LEED projects. Both series are available in NSF and ADA configurations. Cabinet widths come in 3" increments from 12" to 45" wide. All cabinets come fully assembled and ready to install. If legs are not specified, a standard toekick design is provided for each base cabinet. Optional weather stripping is available for outdoor use at no additional cost. We also manufacture custom countertops, islands, and worktables for your home, commercial, or institutional projects. All countertops are made per our client's dimensions. To receive a quote, please contact us with a drawing and description of the project you are working on.

Specifications

Both of our cabinet series are consistent with the industry standard dimensions for kitchen cabinets. Our standard size base cabinets are 34.5 inches high and 24 inches deep. The widths start at 12 inches and increase in 3-inch increments up to 45 inches. Wall cabinets are 12 inches deep and are available in heights and widths from 12 to 45 inches in 3-inch increments. Please see our catalog of cabinets for cabinet drawings and dimensions. Our countertops are constructed from 16-gauge Type 304 #4 finish stainless steel and backed with cabinet quality plywood with a standard countertop thickness of 1-1/2". Please see below for descriptions of each of our cabinet series.

Architectural Series Cabinets

The Architectural Series cabinetry is suitable for both indoor and outdoor kitchens and commercial kitchens, with the option of 6" legs to meet NSF-2 standards applications. Cabinets are constructed entirely of Type 430 stainless with a #4 brushed finish.

Cabinet components are securely assembled, using stainless steel fasteners and corner stiffeners. Blumotion hinges, rails and stainless drawer boxes provide an excellent soft close feature. We only use Blum hardware for all the Architectural series of cabinetry.

Cabinets are shipped with a protective PVC plastic film to protect them until they are installed.

Designer Series Cabinets

For applications where NSF standards are not required, but the appearance of stainless is, we provide our Designer Series cabinets. Using a 5/8" thick quality Russian birch plywood cabinet box, and wrapped on the exterior with the same premium stainless steel used in our Architectural Series, we can provide you with the durability and appearance of stainless steel without the high price. The Russian birch is uniformly constructed with equal veneers entirely of birch. The multi-ply construction helps to provide a consistent, stable, strong and aesthetically attractive panel, is water resistant, and is covered with pressure laminate. This series is suitable for indoor use. All components are securely assembled. Blumotion hinges and rails provide an excellent soft close feature.

Countertops and Islands

Our countertops are constructed from 16-gauge Type 304 #4 finish stainless steel and backed with 3/4" cabinet quality plywood to give you the highest quality in sanitation, appearance and durability. With optional integral sinks, integral backsplashes, cutouts for range tops and/or drop in sinks and small radius corners, we can provide you with the countertop you desire. Marine edge countertops ("drip edge") are also available. Beside straight counters, we can provide L-shaped counters, 45 degree corner counters, and U-shaped counters. Our finish will complement most stainless steel appliances. All welding is ground and blended to a satin finish. Standard countertop thickness is 1-1/2", but other thicknesses can be accommodated.

Integral Sinks

We are committed to providing an entire range of stainless steel products and offer integral sinks in our countertops. The stainless steel sinks we use are constructed of heavy 18 gauge stainless steel, #4 finish. Single and double bowls, standard and rectangular (zero radius) configurations are available. To create a seamless finish, these sinks are integrated (welded-in) into a stainless steel countertop using precision micro-welding and micro-polishing techniques.



Island Worktable

Workspace with options! Our stainless steel worktables can be made with just the base frame (using the countertop material of your choosing) or with our stainless steel top. The worktables can come with standard adjustable feet or with lockable casters so that they can be moved at your convenience. Shelves and drawers can be added to make this worktable exactly what you're looking for. Standard sizes are as follows: 2' x 4', 3' x 4', 4' x 4', 3' x 5', 4' x 5', and 4' x 6'.



Outdoor Applications

A popular use of our Architectural Series cabinetry and countertops is for outdoor kitchens and BBQ areas. Our stainless steel line will stand up to the test of time and weather in your outdoor areas. Weatherstripping is available at no additional cost. Please ask your representative to include this if you want this option.

Green Building Products

For those who are looking for environmentally safe products, with no adverse effects on the environment or the people in it, stainless is ideal. It's recyclable, doesn't emit any pollutants, and is ideal for individuals with chemical sensitivities. We offer LEED suitable products in our Architectural Series cabinetry. We use only ultra-low Volatile Organic Compound (VOC) adhesives. Virtually all products are recyclable at the end of their lives.

Green Attributes

- **Recyclable**

All stainless is recyclable.

The recycle content of stainless steel is 65 to 80%. This is the typical amount of recycled stainless scrap used to make new stainless.

The recycle rate for stainless is 60 to 85% re-melt. (Various grades have different re-melt rates, depending on how common the grade is.)

- **Non Toxic**

Architectural Series: no outgassing.

Designer Series: laminate reduces outgassing to a minimum.

- **Locally Made**

Within 120 miles of Chicago. Steel is purchased from Chicago and in some cases Michigan. Core cabinets in Designer Series are purchased from companies within 30 miles.

- **Green Manufacturing**

No pollutants, chemicals, or contaminants required to form or assemble product.



Guidelines for Buying Stainless Steel Cabinets: Architectural Series

Different stainless steel cabinet and countertop suppliers use different materials and methods for their products. Our products are made from premium materials and come fully assembled.

Below is a comparison guide for our products compared to some of our competitors:

Custom Projects

Not only do we carry a standard line of cabinets, we accept custom projects on a limited basis. All our countertops are customized to fit your space, with many features to fit the needs of your project. Floating shelves and island worktables as part of a larger order are fabricated to your specification. If you would like a quote for your project, please fax or email us your drawings and project information.

Quote and Order Process

Quotes are prepared on an individual basis. For best pricing on cabinets, use standard sizes and multiple units of the same size cabinet as much as possible. Please send a simple drawing of cabinets or countertops, including sizes and layout. If you would like a quick quote or questions about our product, a customer representative will be able to help you.

When you are ready to order (after receiving the initial quote) an invoice will be provided along with our order documents and any drawings provided by our company that are needed for your order. When all the documents are finalized and a deposit is received, your order is placed. The lead time quoted for your project begins when order is finalized. If you have any questions when placing an order, we will be glad to assist you to fully understand the process and our warranty.

Terms

All orders require a 50% deposit, with the balance due 5 business days before shipping. Once accepted, orders are non-returnable and nonrefundable. Full terms and conditions are provided with the invoice or can be requested individually.

Warranty

Products are warranted against defects in workmanship and materials for 5 years from date of delivery. Warranty does not apply to normal wear and tear, improper care, abuse, improper or careless moving and installation, or to costs of shipping, unloading, installation or removal. Warranty does not cover finish. Liability will be limited to repair or replacement of defective product. During the warranty period Stainless Steel Kitchens Inc. will at its option repair or replace defective product. Minor defects in material, such as scratches and pinpoints, do not constitute a material or workmanship defect. Slight differences in appearance of grain where corners and edges are polished are unavoidable and do not constitute a workmanship defect. Stainless Steel Kitchens Inc. is not liable for products not fitting due to changes in other elements of customer's design, nor liable for damage to product or premises during delivery or installation by customer or customer's representative. This warranty is in lieu of all other warranties implied or expressed.
