Increased testing capabilities are now available, and people with symptoms should be tested. Public Health and State now encouraging large scale testing.

- **The CDC has added six new potential symptoms** of COVID-19 their list, a move that is expected to increase the number of patients requiring to be tested including: **chills, repeated shaking with chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, new loss of taste or smell.**
- President Trump's guidelines for **Opening Up America Again**, consist of a three-phased approach to assist state and local officials in safely reopening their economies, getting people back to work, and continuing to protect American lives. **Many states have started to restore commerce and access to public places**, with most requiring continued adherence to strict physical distancing measures.

COVID-19 – State of Wisconsin - leveling off/plateauing




- The **Badger Bounce Back Dashboard** has been added to the Wisconsin DHS website and includes status updates on the **Gating Criteria** in moving the state toward reopening the economy.
- **Brown County** has the highest infection rate of COVID-19 in Wisconsin at 328.3 positive cases per 100,000 people. The increase is attributed to cases linked to a beef production facility in the county.
- Governor Evers issues **Emergency Order #34**, expanding nonessential business opportunities starting 8 a.m., Wednesday, April 29 (Interim Order to **Turn the Dial**).
- The Governor also issued **updated FAQs** on the *Safer at Home Order* extension allowing more nonessential businesses to do more.

COVID-19 – Waukesha County - leveling off/plateauing

- 200 people have **now recovered** from COVID-10 in Waukesha County.
- 30% of people who test positive are hospitalized in Waukesha County.
- **Farmers Market** COVID-19 safety guidance has been developed and distributed.



According to the State of Wisconsin, the below gating criteria must be met before Wisconsin will begin opening back up:

Symptoms	Downward trajectory of influenza-like illnesses (ILI) reported within a 14-day period.	
Symptoms	Downward trajectory of COVID-like syndromic cases reported within a 14-day period.	
Cases	Downward trajectory of positive tests as a percent of total tests within a 14-day period.	
Hospitals	<i>Criteria are currently under development in partnership with Wisconsin healthcare stakeholders.</i>	

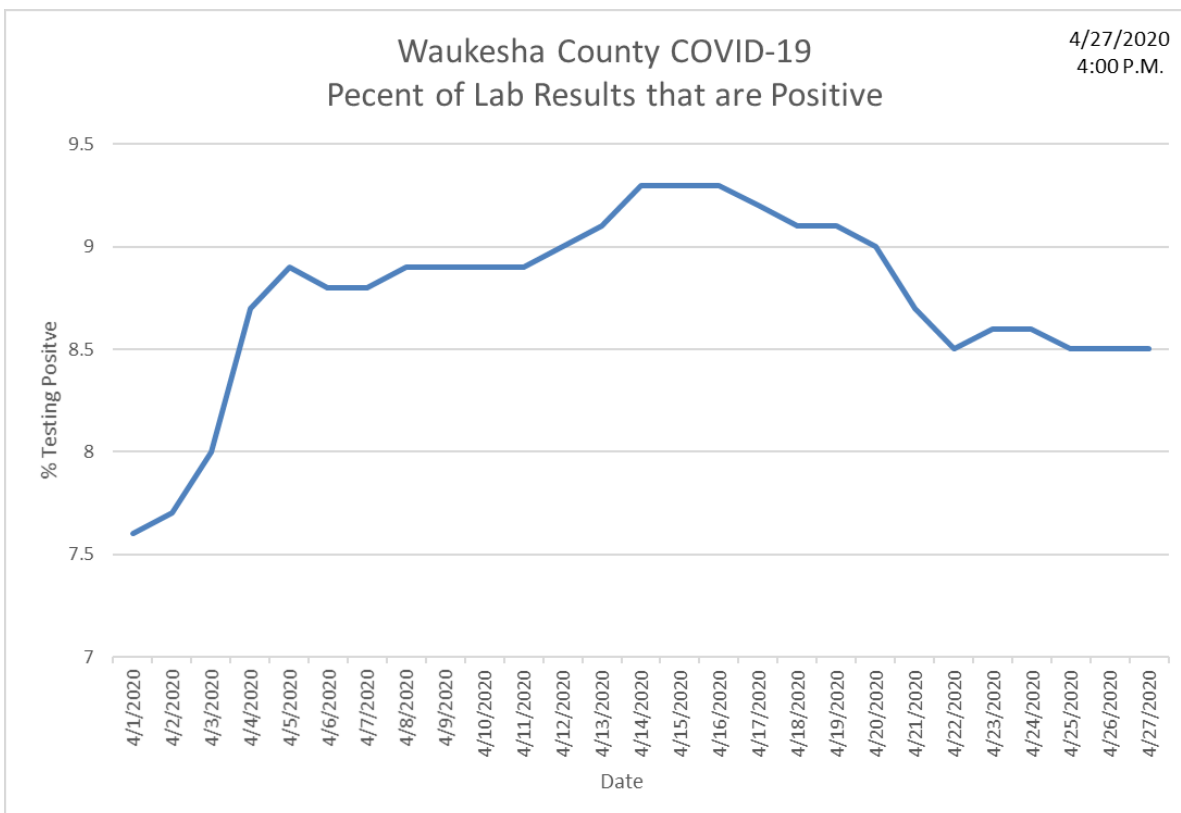


green indicator = gating criteria met (statistically significant downward trend)

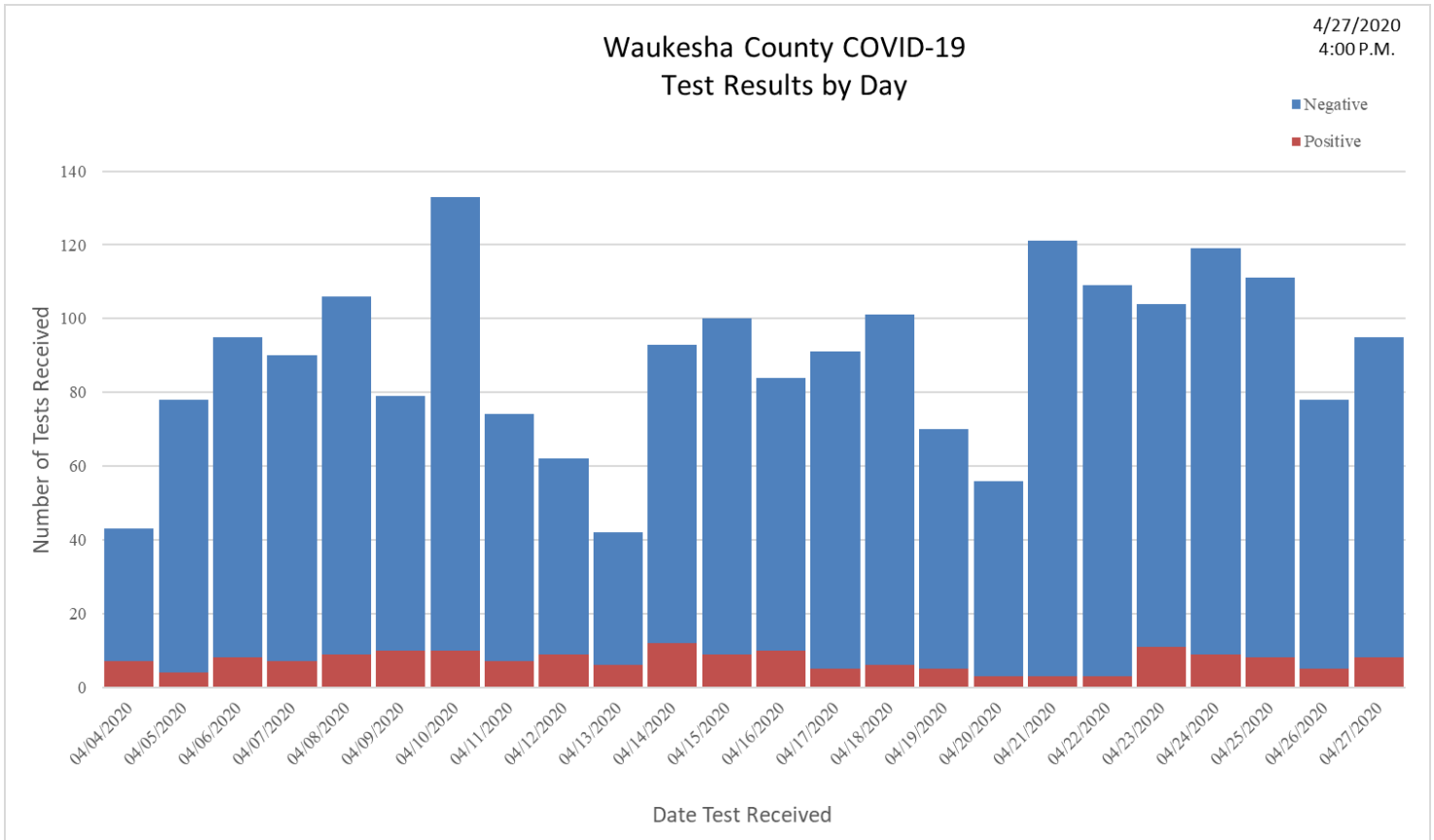


red indicator = gating criteria not met

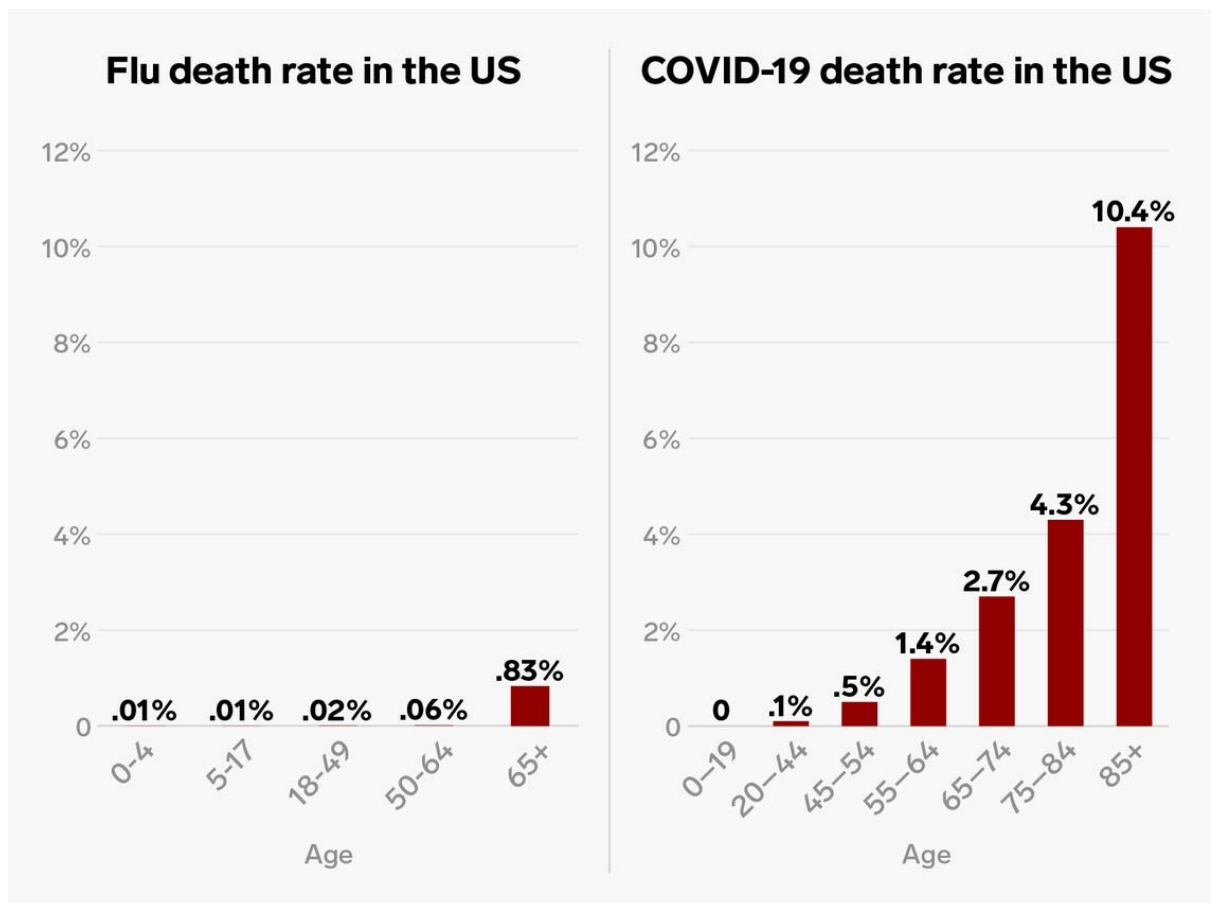

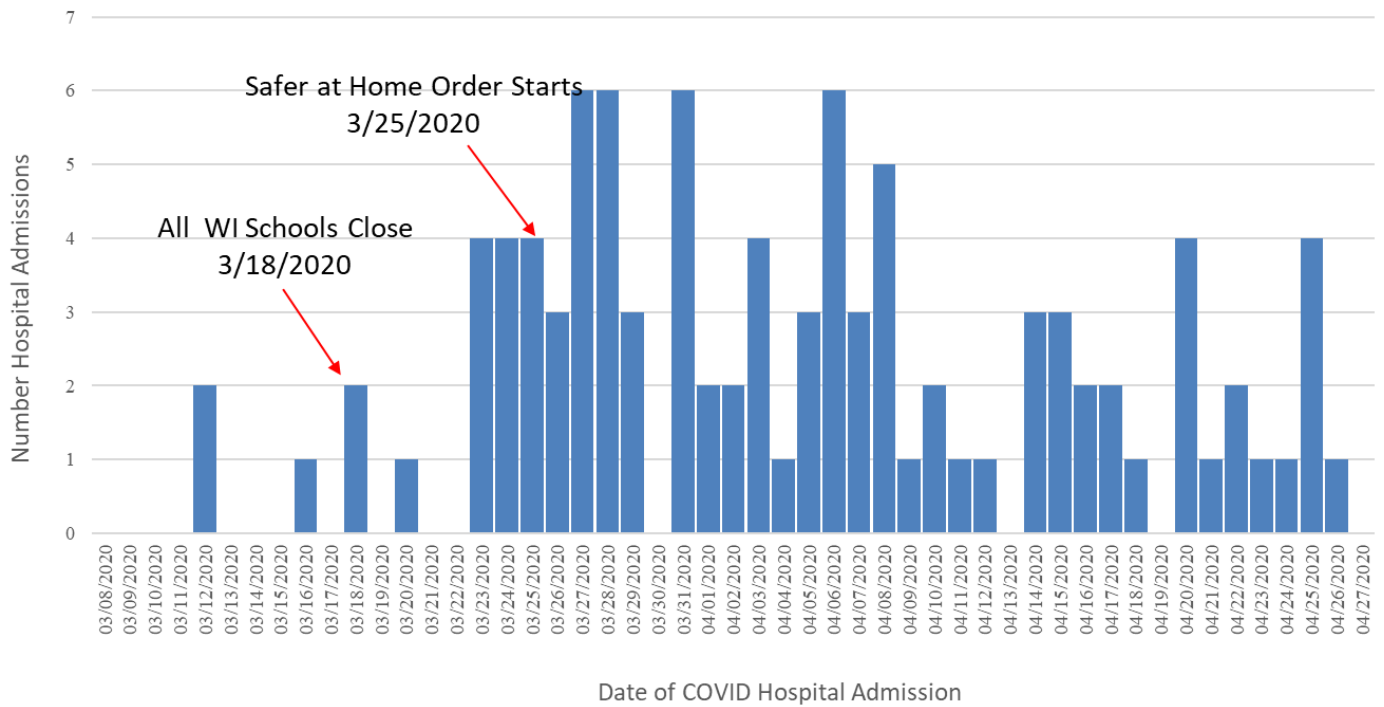
This bar graph shows the daily number of test results received broken down by positive and negative. This graph gives an indication of the level of testing that is occurring in the community.
