Paul W. Tietz, 74 of Sebawaing, died Monday evening, Aug. 15, at St. Luke's Hospital in Saginaw, following an 18-month illness.

He was born Jan. 25, 1920 in Sebawaing, the son of the late Otto and Ida (Erla) Tietz.

Mr. Tietz married Theresa Niece on Feb. 24, 1943. She predeceased him in 1972. He then married Margaret C. Mericksko, March 30, 1974 in Cass City. She survives him.

He had been employed at Gray Iron Foundry in Saginaw for 28 years before retiring in 1975. He also owned and operated a nursery in Sebawaing for many years.

Mr. Tietz was a member of Immanuel Lutheran Church in Sebawaing, had served on the board of elders, was a member of Sebawaing Sportsman's Club and Michigan Steelheaders and was president of the Michigan Club in Florida.

Surviving are his wife Margaret of Sebawaing, two sons, one daughter and their spouses, Gerald and Sandra Tietz, Sebawaing; Carolyn and Harry Sy, Freeland; and Patrick Tietz, at home; seven grandchildren, two great-grandsons, also one brother, Donald Tietz, Sebawaing; several nieces and nephews.

Funeral service took place Friday, Aug. 19 at Immanuel Lutheran Church, Sebawaing. Rev. Martin Hagenow officiated with burial in the church cemetery.
