Newsletters

We offer newsletters to keep our public informed on what we are doing and how we are maintaining the library. We release newsletters bi-monthly, and they are available in the flyer box located outside by the front door.

Our Goal

The library is here to help our community learn and grow. We provide a safe and fun environment for everyone. Our goal is to keep the kids and teens reading all year round, and help adults escape from reality in a book for a few hours.

DVDs

You can rent DVDs for FREE. New release movies and 'R' rated movies are \$1.00 on weekdays and \$2.00 on Fridays and extended holidays. All movies are 1 business day rentals. TV shows and documentaries are 1 week rentals for \$1.00. Video fines are \$1.00 for each day the item is late. No renewals unless you bring the item in, and then we can re-check it out to you.

Books, Books on CD and Magazines

Books, books on CD (for those car rides back and forth to work or long road trips), and magazines are 2 week rentals. Book fines are 10 cents for each day the item is late. We do allow 1 renewal over the phone.

Computer

We do allow patrons to use our computers. For virus reasons, we have some restrictions. There is a 30 minute limit, which can be extended if nobody is waiting. You MUST have a library card to use the computer. The computer printer is available at 10 cents per copy, which can include color copies for 25 cents. You must agree to a waiver before using the internet.

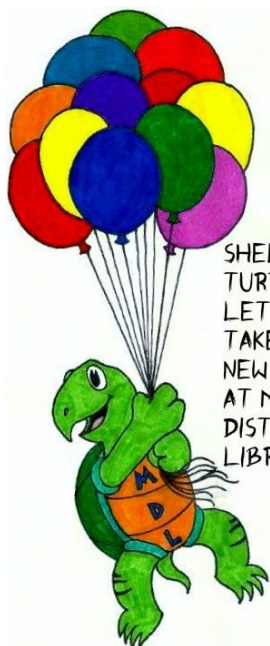
