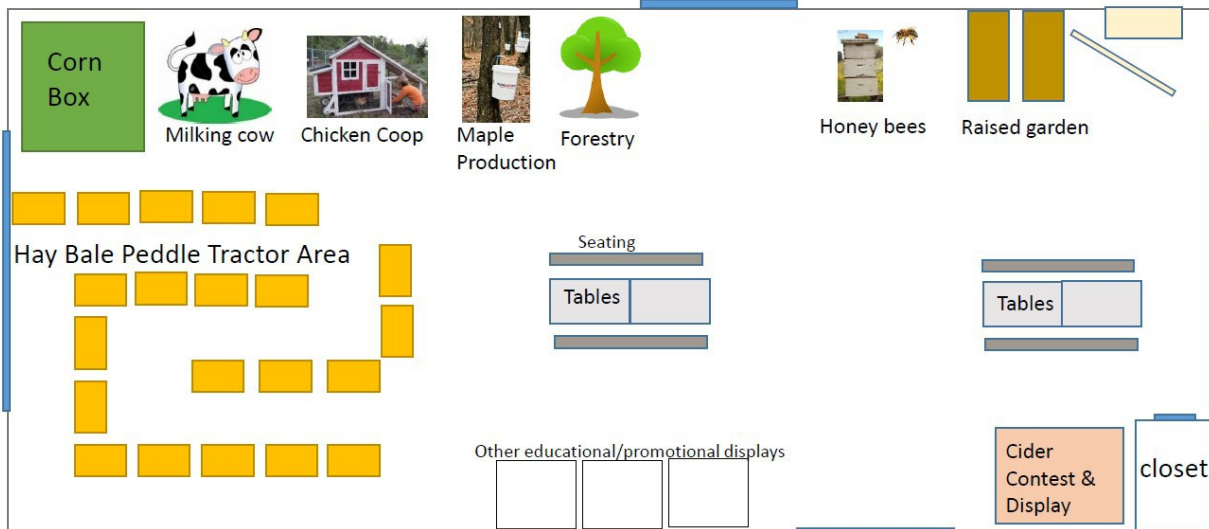


******* The “Vegetable Barn” hosts Ag Education *******

When you’re little, you are not quite tall enough for some of the amusement rides or strong enough to throw a dart at a balloon. New this year, the Fair Board is exploring Ag Education in the former vegetable barn and it’s focused on youth under 8 years old.

There will be at least nine different stations where youth can have hands-on learning (and a few older people can learn too). These stations will include a milking cow, a chicken coop, maple productions, forestry, honey bees, raised gardening, cider, a corn box, and possibly a hay bale peddle tractor area. Each station will have an educational component. And some will have hands-on fun!



Due to volunteers working in food booths, running ticket booths, parking cars, organizing grandstand events, etc., supervision will be the responsibility of all adults walking through the building. The fair board wants this area to be a fun, educational space, so everyone is asked to help tidy it up, to keep all items within the building, and make sure everyone is safe and having a good learning experience. Tables and seating will be available to make the supervision a little easier and more relaxing for the adults.
