As you may know, our programs at Colby's Army (Operation Backpack, Fern's Organic Garden, Operation Job Training, and Therapeutic Riding and Equine Assisted Activities) serve children, adults, and seniors with challenges such as homelessness, cerebral palsy, depression, developmental delay, post traumatic stress, autism, Downs syndrome, bullying, ageing, and more.

Our backpacks filled with street supplies give hope to men and women who are homeless. Our organic garden offers job training to adults with special needs and food for the homeless. And, our equine assisted activities and therapeutic riding teach responsibility, affect, respect, teamwork, time management, leadership, project management, and much more. Plus, our free legal pet directive directs the care and custody of pets nationwide, should his or her owner become unable.

Recently, with the help of Heritage Bank, we were able to purchase the 54-acre farm in Ashland City that we have been leasing for the past three years. ***The purchase opens up new sponsorship opportunities that will bring added visibility to sponsors and allow us to expand our programs. Each sponsorship comes with signage in the area sponsored, and also on our sponsor wall, and is an excellent way to give ongoing exposure to a career or business, or honor a special loved one.***

If you have been out to our learning center, you know that we have a very unique facility. The property was once owned by Grand Ole Opry member Ray Pillow, who sold it to Lee Greenwood. In 1974, Mr. Greenwood built the 53' x 86' barn we now occupy. Since then, the property has been owned by members of Confederate Railroad. Most recently, it has had the addition of Western sets (such as a jail and a saloon), and a dance floor. We also have one mile of hiking trails, and a waterfall.

(A mechanical wooden horse to help teach participants to mount and dismount, and proper position; and to train volunteers, and troubleshoot various lesson strategies. Can be customized in your favorite horse color and name of choice.)		
Indoor Overhead Fans	10 years	\$7,500
(Indoor/outdoor barn fans to help keep participants and volunteers cool.)		
Gazebo	10 years	\$7,500
(To use as an outdoor classroom and serene seating area near our garden and creek)		
Tractor	10 years	\$7,500
(Upgrade to our existing tractor to one with a front bucket on it, 4WD, hydraulics, and easier driving so more volunteers can use it.)

(To provide a dry and shady area for group lessons. Currently, our special needs participants often have to cancel sessions due to rain or too much sun. This area will also be utilized for special events, community meetings, etc.)		
Entire Campus: The Colby's Army Learning Center, (Your Name) Campus	In perpetuity	\$300,000
