Faith...The gift of eternal life is received by faith.

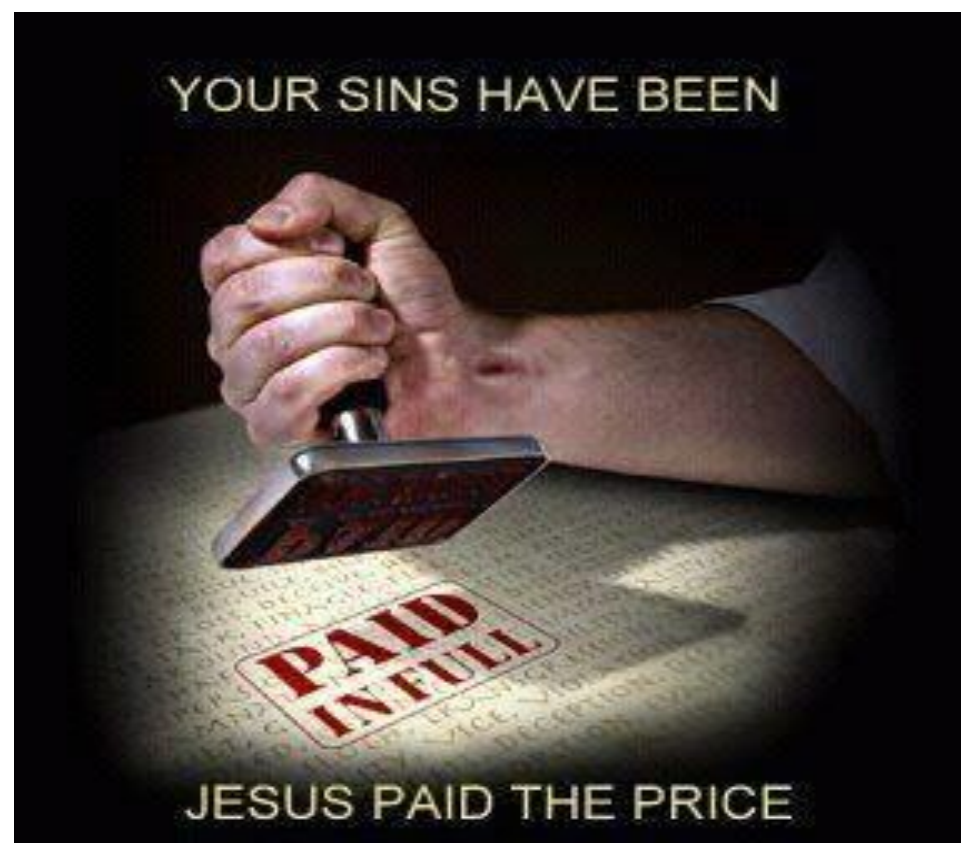
