SAFETY ORTS:

Safety class/Renewals:

Safety classes are required for ALL membership renewals. Classes for next year's renewals have begun. There will be multiple opportunities to attend a safety class both following the regular club meetings and at other scheduled times, to be announced. A safety class is required for each year. There will be no more membership renewals until March at the regular renewal time. New members will be allowed to join in January at the pro-rated price of \$20. No new members will be accepted in February.

EVENTS:

Club Shoots:

There is no club shoot scheduled for January. February club shoot will be the Valentine's couple shoot. "Couples" can be any team of two people. Shoot is any caliber.

Plaques for those placing in the 2019 shoots will be presented at the January meeting.

Member Renewals

Membership renewal is moving from December to March for next year's renewals. This change is to allow renewals to happen when members might have fewer activities and more available cash. The gun drawing for the following year will be held in April.
