


Appreciating our history . . .

Dr. Ron Haithcock – June 14-18



Dr. Ron Haithcock is a Kannapolis native and Kannapolis First Wesleyan is his home church. He currently pastors Providence Wesleyan Church in High Point, North Carolina. Ron is married to Susan Davis Haithcock and they have four children and four grandchildren. Ron graduated from Southern Wesleyan University with a Bachelor of Arts in Psychology then continued his education at Asbury Theological

Seminary where he obtained his Master of Divinity Degree. He later went to Drew University in Madison, New Jersey, and graduated with his Doctor of Ministry Degree. Ron has pastored several churches in the North Carolina West District of The Wesleyan Church through the years and has served in district leadership capacities as well.

Dr. Steve Wingfield – June 20-24



Evangelist Steve Wingfield comes to us from Virginia. He is a graduate of Trinity Evangelical Divinity School and Eastern Mennonite College and has an honorary Doctor of Divinity degree from Liberty Baptist Theological Seminary in Lynchburg, Virginia. He serves as CEO and evangelist of the Steve Wingfield Evangelistic Association, which is dedicated to the awakening and renewal of

the local church through festival evangelism. Over 100 citywide crusades and festivals have been conducted in the United States during his 20 years of evangelistic ministry. Additionally, he founded "The Valley Responds," a humanitarian ministry charged with helping rebuild Katrina ravaged areas of the United States. Dr. Wingfield has authored numerous articles, pamphlets and books and is a featured instructor at Billy Graham's Institute for Emerging Evangelists in Asheville, North Carolina, and the Tyndale Theological Seminary in Amsterdam, Netherlands. Since 1988, his international ministry has extended to over 30 countries including Romania. He frequently speaks at retreats, conferences, universities and special events.

Nathan will focus on men's groups and meetings and children's and youth ministries and will help with the worship music at the

church. Kenzie will focus on various women's groups and meetings along with children's and youth ministries. Together, they hope to help teach language and life-skill classes at the centers and will also assist with Arabic Christian literature distribution in several open-air markets. The work at the centers provides an opportunity to meet and assist North Africans as they build relationships with each other and introduce them to Jesus. These ministries all focus on building community as they connect with the people of North Africa for His glory.

DIRECTIONS

From Concord - Take the Kannapolis Parkway to Mooresville Road (Hwy. 3). Turn right and go down to Charlie Walker Road and turn left. Charlie Walker Road becomes Enochville Avenue. Turn left on Wright Road. Go to the end of Wright Road and turn left. Immediately turn left again on Deal Road. Camp Wesley is about a mile ahead on the right.

From Kannapolis - Go to the end of West "C" Street and turn left on Enochville Avenue. Turn right on Wright Road. Go to the end of Wright Road and turn left. Immediately turn left again on Deal Road. Camp Wesley is about a mile ahead on the right.

From China Grove - Take Hwy. 152 West and turn left on Deal Road at the Atwell Fire Station. Camp Wesley is 3.2 miles on the right.

From Landis - Take Hwy. 153 to Hwy. 152 West and turn left on Deal Road at the Atwell Fire Station. Camp Wesley is 3.2 miles on the right.

From I-77 - Take Exit 36 to Hwy. 150 East. Go 6.3 miles and take Hwy. 152 East toward China Grove. Go 3.7 miles and turn right on Unity Church Road. Go to the stop sign and turn left on Deal Road. Camp Wesley is just ahead on the left.



Camp History

Camp Wesley's history spans seventy years. As early as 1936, a small group of Christians organized by Mr. M. C. Scercy erected the first arbor on the property of G. L. Rogers in rural Rowan County, North Carolina.

In 1946, M. C. Scercy's nephew, Rev. William Scercy, felt led of the Lord to organize a camp meeting board. Several selected men with interest in beginning a camp meeting gathered at the home of Mr. Ray Daniels of Kannapolis, NC on September 6, 1946. The motion carried to name the camp, "Camp Wesley Interdenominational Holiness Camp".

The first camp meeting was held August 1-10, 1947. The group soon purchased a five-acre plot of land from Mr. G. L. Rogers, still the current site of Camp Wesley. The first permanent buildings on the grounds were a 60' by 80' open-air tabernacle and a small dining hall. Today, ten buildings cover the Camp Wesley grounds, including our beautiful new "Rebecca Jester McHargue Fellowship Center."

With an eye toward the future, the Camp Wesley board purchased an additional five acres adjoining the property with plans for recreational areas, an additional dormitory and RV/camper space. To further aid in Camp Wesley's development, an additional tract measuring 140 by 150 feet adjacent to the camp was donated to Camp Wesley during the 1999 Camp Meeting.

Rev. William Scercy, W.H. Hall, Rev. Frank Ostwalt, Grover Beaver, and Rev. E.T. Houston have served as past presidents of the camp. Rev. Trent Patterson, the current camp president, and the Camp Wesley directors look forward to many years of continued ministry in the community.
