UPON ADMISSION You Will Be On A 30 day Probationary Period And All GUIDELINES WILL BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO:

*******To enter Naaman's Program*******

- (1) You can have no violent charges on record**
- (2) You can have no sexual/Child Abuse charges**
- (3) Must have valid drivers license or ID card and Social Security card
- (4) Must Check in weekly and attend Celebrate Recovery prior to entering house

*******ONLY THE ADMINASTOR DIRECTOR OR INTAKE CORDOINATOR
CAN MAKE ANY SPECIAL ALLOWANCES*******

Rule #1: All cell phones must be surrendered or left behind. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Rule #2: No personal phone calls will be made or received.

There is a house phone that **ONLY** the Resident House Manager will answer. He will either call you to the phone or take a message for you.

Rule #3: All vehicle keys must be surrendered or left behind until you enter the "Work Phase"

Rule #4: There will be no off-campus visitation for the first 4 weeks at NRV,

Rule #5: Visitation for the first 4 weeks will be limited to Clergy, Attorney, Parole/Probation officer, and Mentor.

Rule #6: You will get up at 5:30 AM and be in bed no later than 11:00PM

Rule #7: You will work on campus and off campus.

Rule #8: You will complete all class/scheduled assignments, attend all classes/meetings, Church Services and assigned fund raisers/functions. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Rule #9: ALL cash, debit, credit cards are to be surrendered until needed, or left behind with Family NO EXCEPTIONS.
