



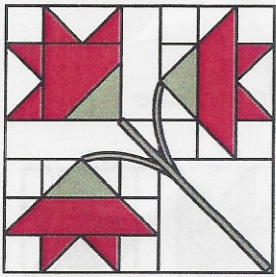

Cutting Instructions	One Block
Block Print	1 - 4 1/2" square (A) 2 - 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangles (B) 8 - 2 1/2" squares (C)
Accent Print	1 - 10" x 10" square (D) 1 - 3 1/2" square (E) 2 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (F)
Background	1 - 6 1/2" square (G) 1 - 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" rectangle (H) 1 - 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangle (I) 4 - 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles (J) 8 - 2 1/2" squares (K) 9 - 2 1/2" squares (L)

Use 1/4" seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

Block Assembly

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric C squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric C square on one end of a Fabric J rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.



Repeat on the opposite end.

Petal Unit should measure 2 1/2" x 4 1/2".



Make 4.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric E square.

With right sides facing, layer the Fabric E square on the bottom right corner of the Fabric A square.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim 1/4" away from the seam.

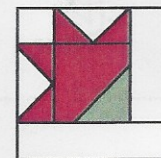
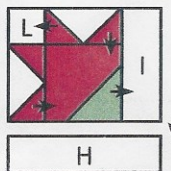
Corner Petal Unit should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2".



Make 1.

Assemble Unit.

Corner Flower Unit should measure 8 1/2" x 8 1/2".



Make 1.

Small floral print but NOT PINK!

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric K squares.

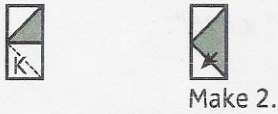
With right sides facing, layer a Fabric K square on the top end of a Fabric F rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



Repeat on the bottom end.

Leaf Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ ".



With right sides facing, layer a Fabric K square on the top end of a Fabric B rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the seam.



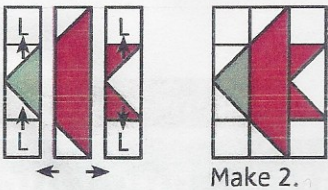
Repeat on the bottom end.

Large Petal Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".



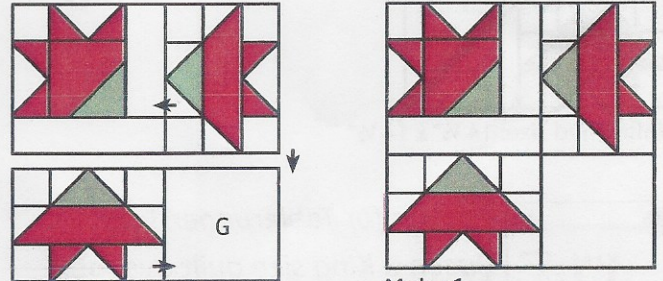
Assemble Unit.

Carolina Lily Unit should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Assemble Unit.

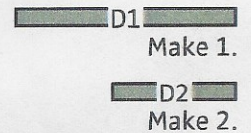
Partial Carolina Lily Block Unit should measure $14\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Using the 45 degree line on a quilting ruler, subcut the Fabric D square on the bias into:

- 1 - 1 " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " strip (D1)
- 2 - 1 " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " strips (D2)

Using a $\frac{1}{2}$ " bias tape maker, create $\frac{1}{2}$ " bias tape from the Fabric D Bias Strips.



Position the Fabric D2 Strips and the Fabric D1 Strip. Applique in place.

Carolina Lily Block should measure $14\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ ".
