Car Parking at Church

- 1 The grass car park at the bottom of the back lane to the Church and Harcourt is sufficiently firm for parking. Please, just be aware of starting to reverse off slowly, keeping wheels straight, before turning back onto the lane.
- 2 The gravelling down the field side of the lane to the front of the Church is now largely completed. This provides a cleaner line of parking for up to 9 cars, still with turning space at the top and middle. The lane has been widened by up to a metre over the last two years and careful double parking will still allow a clear through passageway for vehicles using the lane.
