Supervisor May called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. at the town hall located at 3529 Rt. 20A, Warsaw, New York.

Supervisor May opened with the Pledge of Allegiance; all were thanked for attending the meeting. There were no questions or comments from the audience.

Supervisor May introduced Joanna Craigmile, Adam Vetter and Dianna Wilcox. Ms. Craigmile has been researching Town by Town – parcel by parcel to which fire district each parcel is in at this time. The Fire districts were established in 1961 and prior to that in 1952 the middle of Orangeville Center Road was the dividing line between Varysburg and Warsaw districts. There also was a model with fire response time from Varysburg and Warsaw. EMS and Fire districts are the same. Ms. Craigmile discussed the maps that were presented and the parcels that will be affected. October 12, 2023

There will have to be a public hearing to discuss this with the residents, all information will be sent to Mr. DiMatteo's office for review to move the odd parcels to match the map and correct district.

Supervisor May requested a motion to approve the minutes from September 14, 2023. <u>Highway Superintendent Report</u>: Mr. Roggow requested that the department go back to winter hours. On a motion by Mr. Ahl, seconded by Mr. Herman to have the Highway Department to go back on winter hours. Wethersfield has been asking for our help on cutting down the hill and help with the roads, we have been ditching also. Have helped Eagle, Attica and installed a driveway. We have been working on the trucks, 205 has the clip on. Antifreeze was getting in to the exhaust. Started fall mowing, and give BIDS to the Town Clerk. Looking at a small addition for the cold storage building, for the excavator and stuff. Looking at pricing for cement. Mr. Roggow requested a motion to be allowed to run electric to the storage building under the use of ARPA funds. On a motion by Mr. Herman, seconded by Mr. Flint to approve the improvements to the storage building. Supervisor May discussed the information regarding purchasing an AED for the Town Hall, and training for the Highway staff and the court staff. She will also check on grant monies for this purchase. The cost that she has been quoted is \$1,849.00.

Town Clerk Report: The Towns total revenue for the month of September 2023 was \$1,434.00, \$905.00 for Zoning, \$234.00 for dog licenses, \$5.00 for late fee for dogs, \$290.00 for DEC. We had 22 dog licenses. We disbursed \$130.00 to Wyoming County, \$30.00 to Ag and Markets for dogs, \$274.01 to DEC, and \$999.99 to the General Account. (DEC-\$15.99, Dog license \$74.00, \$5.00 late fee for dogs and \$905.00 for Zoning)

Supervisor May stated that Adam Cook that we were considering for an appointment as Town Prosecutor, but has resigned from the DA office.

Ms. Cindy Goral commented that she is amazed by all the Town Board does for the Town and wanted to personally thank them.

Supervisor May requested a motion to approve the 2023 Highway Fund Bills: Abstract #10 Vouchers #159 through #171 totaling \$39,258.86. A motion was made by Mr. Flint, seconded by Mr. Herman to approve the payment of the Highway Fund bills.
