

Quilting Guidelines

Preparation before you bring your quilt to us:

- Backing fabric needs to be at least 6" wider and longer than your quilt top.
- Trim away any loose threads on the back to prevent shadowing or threads protruding from the seams on the top of your quilt.
- If your quilt and back are directional or needs centering, please indicate with a note pinned to the appropriate side of the quilt and back.

Services that we provide:

- We will consult with you to choose the best design, thread and finishing services for your quilt.
- Our services include Pantograph, many levels of complexity, and free motion, custom design, outlining and echo quilting.
- We have a variety of quality battings including cotton and wool. We charge by the yard.
- We will use your batting if you prefer.
- We will trim your quilt to the edge of the top, ready for you to bind, unless otherwise indicated on the order form.
- We will do our best to blend tucks, puckers and stretched areas.
- Binding services include many options. Please see price list.
- For hand quilters, we will baste your quilt on the machine, 4" to 6" apart. All the requirements remain the same.
- We hope that you will allow us to use an image of your quilt to show the quality of our work.
