

RESOLUTION NO. 11-117 N.C.

DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXPLORE OPPORTUNITIES FOR COLLABORATION AND SHARED USE OF FACILITIES, EQUIPMENT AND SERVICES WITH THE GREATER VALLEJO RECREATION DISTRICT (GVRD), THE VALLEJO CITY UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT (VCUSD), THE SOLANO COMMUNITY COLLEGE, THE SOLANO COUNTY LIBRARY, AND THE VALLEJO SANITATION AND FLOOD CONTROL DISTRICT (VSFCD)

WHEREAS, local government agencies continue to struggle with diminishing resources, both fiscal and human, in providing services to their constituents; and

WHEREAS, local government agencies need to come up with innovative methods of providing services while at the same time reducing expenses; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vallejo, the Greater Vallejo Recreation District ("GVRD"), the Vallejo City Unified School District ("VCUSD"), the Solano Community College, the Solano County Library, and the Vallejo Sanitation and Flood Control District (VSFCD) recognize that there may be areas of common interest and duplication of services within these agencies; and

WHEREAS, these agencies each maintain their own buildings, properties, vehicles, equipment, and provide administrative support services such as Human Resources and Information Technology (IT) services and that these costs are duplicated by each agency; and

WHEREAS, the City of Vallejo, the Greater Vallejo Recreation District, the Vallejo City Unified School District, the Solano Community College, the Solano County Library, and the Vallejo Sanitation and Flood Control District (VSFCD) would like to explore opportunities for collaboration and shared use of facilities, equipment and services in an effort to reduce costs and maintain service levels.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Vallejo directs the City Manager to appoint a staff representative to explore and work with staff from each agency to implement shared use of services, facilities, property, and equipment that would either: 1) reduce cost; 2) increase or maintain service levels that might otherwise be at risk due to diminishing resources; or 3) provide efficiencies.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that staff should provide a report to the City Council on its progress, including any recommendations requiring Council action by October 1, 2011.
