Meant to Grow By M.D.

"... But, speaking the truth in love, may grow up in all things into Him who is the head—Christ—" (Ephesians 4:15)

God expects us to grow and continue to grow. Our Heavenly Father's goal for us is to mature and develop the character of Jesus Christ. Sadly, many Christians grow older yet never grow up. Listen here how Paul addresses being stuck in spiritual infancy, "And I, brethren, could not speak to you as to spiritual people but as to carnal, as to babes in Christ. I fed you with milk and not with solid food; for until now you were not able to receive it, and even now you are still not able; for you are still carnal. For where there are envy, strife, and divisions among you, are you not carnal and behaving like mere men?" (1 Corinthians 3:1-3) And now the author of Hebrews 5:12 says this, "For though by this time you ought to be teachers, you need someone to teach you again the first principles of the oracles of God; and you have come to need milk and not solid food."

Spiritual growth is not automatic. We must be committed to growth, wanting to grow AND persistent to growing! Disciple-ship; do you know what that is? One who is a student of Jesus and helps to spread His message. The process of becoming Christ-like. Jesus calls - and we respond. Let's read *Matthew 9:9* together, "As Jesus passed on from there, He saw a man named Matthew sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, "Follow Ma." So he arose and followed Him." When the first disciples followed Jesus they didn't know all that they were being called to. But they willingly responded to Jesus' call. That's how growth starts; willingly answer the call of Christ. Our commitments are what shape our life. No matter what they might be! Commitments either develop us or destroy us, either way they will define you! We cannot afford to be afraid to be committed to God, and just drift through life. In and out of prison, being half hearted.

For growth it takes both God and us. Christ likeness being the result of depending on and making a decision with the Holy Spirit. Change in thoughts and actions shows our growth. We must let go of old habits, routines, friends and even family if necessary. The Holy Spirit doesn't get it wrong and will help us with these decisions. Listen again to Paul, here in *Philippians 2:12-13*, "Therefore, my beloved, as you have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; for it is God who works in you both to will and to do for His good pleasure." We are able to work out our Salvation because we already possess it! God has given us a new life, now it is up to us to develop it! "With Fear and trembling" means to take our spiritual growth seriously! If not, then you do not understand the eternal consequences of your actions! Do you realize that behind everything we do, there is a thought? Every action shows a belief. God tells us, in *Proverbs 23:7*, "For as he thinks in his heart, so is he."

When we try ourselves, without God, that's willpower. And in willpower we always have that force pushing back and eventually we tire out. Willpower doesn't deal with the root of the problem, it simply tries to impose its will. There's the difference. God doesn't impose His will, He deals with the root of the problems. Here in *Romans 12:2-3* we see, "And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God. For I say, through the grace given to me, to everyone who is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, as God has dealt to each one a measure of faith." I believe that growth starts in the mind. The way you think determines how you feel, how you act, what you do dwell on and determines the outcome of any situation. Here in *Ephesians 4:23* Paul tells us, "and that you be renewed in the spirit of your mind ..."

To be Christ-like we must develop the mind of Christ. In the New Testament this change of mind is called 'repentance'. And in the Greek 'repentance' literally means - to change your mind. When we repent, what are we doing? We take on Christ's outlook and perspective. *Philippians 2:5* shows us, "Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus ..." Paul tells us to have the same attitude as Christ. Immaturity was NOT in Christ and shouldn't be in us! "Brethren, do not be children in understanding; however, in malice be babes, but in understanding be mature." (1 Corinthians 14:20) A sure sign of maturity is thinking of others. Check out what Paul says as you all read 1 Corinthians 13. Maturity thinks of others! Some people think that spiritual maturity is measured by our Biblical knowledge, but that's not the whole measurement. Conduct, character and our deeds must go with what we confess. Our beliefs must be backed up with Christ-like behavior! Christianity is no religion, but a relationship and a lifestyle with Jesus!

I'll close with these Scriptures. "Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God. These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual." (1 Corinthians 2:12-13) And "We then who are strong ought to bear with the scruples of the weak, and not to please ourselves. Let each of us please his neighbor for his good, leading to edification. For even Christ did not please Himself; but as it is written, 'The reproaches of those who reproached You fell on Me.'" (Romans 15:1-3)

Pain of Discipline vs Pain of Regret By J.M.

I want to thank you for the card I received. I was brought to tears by both the gesture and the contents. And before I get to the content in which I wish to share, I would like to back up a bit so you all can see, as I share, how God is using the Over-conces for Official and others to work in my life.

I reached my 18 month mark until my release back in December. Being a RSS here for the last 15 months, I have learned that there is no such thing as over preparation. Especially when it comes to the rest of my life. See, when released, I will have almost 16 years of being locked up. Most guys don't start preparation until they are 6 months to the gate. As I've said, I decided I would start at 18 months.

Now, since December I have been diligent about daily time spent in the Word and my time with God. I believe that the **Pain of Discipline** to be always less than the **Pain of Regret**. It's the best part of my day to center myself before the chaos or complacency hits. I find it truly interesting how either one can do great amounts of damage. I listen to the 'Daily Audio Bible' podcast on my tablet and read along. I have been faithful to this since the first of the year. I also started tithing 10% of everything I make or comes in every month. Seeing how reading the OC+C newsletter is like going to church for me every month I send my tithe to you.

The first week of February I started actively looking for a program and a place to go. I had some prerequisites; 6 month minimum, 12 step and Christian based, somewhere I could ease back into society. I didn't want to go to a place that would put me in debt as soon as I got there. As I started looking around that day I found a friend who was going to Alongside Ministries via a place called, New Freedom. That night another friend brought over a newsletter from GCHH/New Freedom. I had heard of this organization from my RSS supervisor while inquiring about future RSS employment. Then I noticed that Alongside and New Freedom were under the same umbrella of GCHH. Then after reading the 2 newsletters my friend showed me I realized, most of the individuals running this place were once ex-cons like me! Immediately I thought of you and Tracy Kovach and the inspiration the both of you have had on my current path and journey.

I prayed on it and sent in the application for membership there at GCHH. Then the morning of February 27th, a Saturday, I was reading the February issue of the Overcomers for Official newsletter. As I started to read this passage under 'What Others Are Saying' I thought, "This sounds familiar." Well of course it did, because it was me. I never write to get published, so I was overwhelmed by the presence of the Holy Spirit. Then on March 2nd I received a card from you postmarked February 27th! It lifted me up when you told me that Tracy Kovach works at GCHH/New Freedom. All of this was like a huge neon sign calling to me. I always thought that one day, if I could get a job at ADOCRR it would be full circle for me. 'Whatever Our Hearts Need, the Lord Knows' was the caption on the card you had sent me.

God is moving in my life and I am able to finally be clear headed and sober enough to feel and acknowledge it!

Brother 'Duck' here ... All prayer requests are special to us here and this one is from a near and dear close friend of mine, W.R. We all know that the Word of God tells us, "Is anyone among you sick? Let them call the elders of the church to pray over them and anoint them with oil in the name of the Lord. (And the prayer offered in faith will make the sick person well; the Lord will raise them up.) If they have sinned, they will be forgiven. Therefore confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective." (James 5:14-16 brackets mine) Perhaps there's a brother out there near W.R. that can anoint him with oil but either way I know that there are MANY of you brothers and sister out there that believe in God's Word as His promise and that's exactly why I'm personally sharing this with you all. Scripture here doesn't say that there needs to be thousands of people praying to MAKE God heal. No! That's foolish! It says, "The prayer of (A) righteous person is powerful and effective." You all know that ALL OF YOU ARE the Orcromore for Oficial church, right where you are! And over these past 14 years we've seen God do many great and amazing things through, the power of His Word. All we are asked to do, by God, is to pray His will. "What is His will," you ask? It's so simple! To make it easy for all mankind, God wrote His will down on the pages of His Word, the Bible. Now listen to the simple way John tells how we are going to get our prayers answered. "This is the CONFIDENCE we have in approaching God: that IF WE ASK ANYTHING ACCORDING TO HIS WILL (His Word); HE HEARS US. AND IF WE KNOW THAT HE HEARS US - WHATEVER WE ASK - WE KNOW THAT WE HAVE WHAT WE ASKED OF HIM." (1 John 5:14-15) Do you believe this? I know you do, that's why I'm bringing this to the elders of the Switterners for Shriet church! W.R. sent this to us so we could pray for these specific things.

I'm going to walk you through this real quick so you'll know what's happening to lift in your prayer. You know that I had two back surgeries five years ago. They fused my L-2-3-4 and 5 together. Now, everything has come loose, screws, etc. I have three herniated disks, another one bulging, severe spinal symois and other things going on that I can't even pronounce. I'm in so much pain brother that I can't even walk sometimes. My blood pressure is 190 over 110. Also, as you know, I have a diseased aorta, thinning of the walls, with plaque and cysts in the same area. The cysts showed up about six months ago when they did a cat scan and MRI on my back. I seen a surgeon in December but he's reluctant to do surgery on my back due to my age and the aorta issues. He's ordered a more updated scan on the aorta due to it getting worse. I'm fighting with medical right now to see the surgeon again. I want to talk to him about burning the nerves in my back in hopes of eliminating enough pain that I can then live with it. You know my sister died of the very same issues.

It seems like a never ending battle brother. But I know the battle belongs to the Lord so I'm not worrying about it. Even when the Hebrew people went into the Promised Land God told them, 'I'm giving this land to you and I will deliver you. But, you will have to fight for it!' Regardless of everything I've explained here, I'm still standing on God's Word, His promises to heal me. I KNOW He will because He is faithful to His Word brother ... W.R.

I would like to ask you all to pray for me, as I am in the final stages of preparing my first Federal Habeas. I believe that the Lord has guided my thoughts and words, and He has a plan whether this filing is successful or not. He is still in control; I am doing what I feel He has directed me to do. I am standing firm on His promises ... R.A.

I need prayer and His guidance. In four months I'm getting out of prison after eight years. I'm praying and believing that as God lights my path and directs my footsteps, that I follow Him and praise Him even in the not so good of times. And here is the area I'm conflicted in. I've been watching the Freedom Channel here in prison. They say that upon your release you should not return to a toxic relationship. My girlfriend says she loves me and has been with me for over 13 years. I know she drinks a lot but none of us are perfect and all fall short of the glory of God. I know this relationship is not good for the success of my re entry but I don't know what to say to her. I want to follow Him with all my mind, heart and soul now and forever! Please pray for this matter ... S.M.

I know that God does hear and answer prayer. So, if you would, please lift me in your prayers. There's no real rehabilitation in prison.

Rehabilitation, or change is a person's choice. Change happens from the inside out. I'm ready for a full commitment and change in my life. Lord, I'm ready for Your help. I'm ready to have the good future You have planned for my life while I live for You ... M.C.

I've got a prayer request to ask you all to pray for. I'd like it if everyone would lift my little brother up. That he too would get on his knees and ask God to forgive him and help him with the drug problem he is having. He is my youngest brother and the only brother that I have left. I've lost all my brothers to drugs or alcohol. Again, please lift this request to the Lord ... A.M.

My desire and dream as I pray is to have a church in East Los Angeles called the Great American Church. A church where Mexican Americans love God, people and America! A foothold in California where ex convicts can run for office. My other prayer and desire is to one day be the next conservative Mayor of Los Angeles in a long time. I have big dreams and believe that God has placed these things in my heart so I really need prayer for His wisdom, understanding and to remain humble through this process ... A.J.

Are not even the tax collectors doing that?" Now let's consider the Apostle Paul's words in Philippians 4:13, "I can do all this through Him who gives me strength."

Let me leave you all with this, from John Bunyan (1628-1688), author of *The Pilgrim's Progress*, offered these insights regarding prayer, "In prayer it is better to have a heart without words than words without heart. Pray often, for prayer is a shield to the soul, a sacrifice to God and a scourge for satan. Prayer will make a man cease from sin, or sin will entice a man to cease from prayer. In all your prayers forget not to thank the Lord for His mercies. The spirit of prayer is more precious than treasures of gold and silver. The truths that I know best I have learned on my knees. I never know a thing well, till it is burned into my heart by prayer. To pray rightly, you must make God your hope stay, and all."

Love, Forgiveness and Mercy By J.A.

I have a word that I'd like to share about love, forgiveness and mercy from the Daily Bread and Sparkling Gems Devotionals. In Luke 23:34 Jesus said, "Father, largive them, for they do not know what they are doing," Here, in Luke 23 we get a front row seat to the execution scene of Jesus who died a criminal's death on the Cross for our sins and these following words of Jesus could be heard, "Father, largive them, for they do not know what they are doing," Though the hate filled initiative of the religious leaders resulted in the crucifixion of Jesus, the very One who championed love, forgiveness and mercy, even in agony and suffering, Jesus' love, forgiveness and mercy continued to triumph.

It was used in reference to canceling a debt or releasing someone from an obligation of a contract, a commitment or a wrong he has committed. In essence the word "forgive", in the Greek, is the picture of totally freeing and releasing someone; to be merciful to others.

So right now, I pray: "Dear heavenly Father, I thank You that You do forgive us of our sins, trespasses and debts as we forgive and liberate completely and set free all those sin, trespass or are debtors against us. And bless all those who curse us and revile us as we do good to all those who hate us. I pray for all those who persecute and spitefully use us. Father, forgive them for they do not know what they are doing. And Father, I personally let go of all the anger, hatred, bit-terness, un forgiveness, strife, envy, selfish ambition and jealousies. I also pray dear heavenly Father, that You fill our hearts with Your love, Your peace and Your joy which passes all our understanding to guard our hearts and minds, in Christ Jesus our Lord. Amen! and Amen!"

To all the brothers and sisters in the Overcours for Oficial ministry and family, let the peace of Christ and God rule in our hearts, since as members of one body we were called to peace. Never Forgotten, God Cares About Me By P.M.

Dear Overwinders for Officiet, I am currently incarcerated at A.D.O.C in one of the female prisons. I am currently housed in a medium custody yard and this is my first time writing you, but this is a long time coming. I've been receiving your newsletters, even when I have failed to send a change of address! It has been three years now, maybe longer, but your newsletters have always reached me, especially when times were tough within these walls. Here's a little of my testimony.

I am 34 years old now serving a 40 year flat sentence, with a lifetime probation tail. I was convicted on two second degree charges and one charge of child abuse.

For some reason, for awhile now, I've been wanting to not only write to all of you to thank you for the newsletters, but to share my testimony, too. I've read so many times where 'Duck' would write on something I needed to read. Your newsletter has comforted me many times, and at first I'd be stunned because the Ocac about me, about individuals like myself that society has deemed 'criminals' and thrown into the depths of a broken system. I truly do appreciate each and every one of you there at the Ocac for Christ. I honestly do feel like family. None of you know me, but faithfully you make sure I do receive my newsletter. I've cried, I've had prayers answered, questions answered, and all thanks to you all! I can honestly say that I've come closer to God through your newsletter. You guys do not realize how much impact you have made in my life thus far, especially knowing the circumstances of why I'm in prison.

Unfortunately, tragedy struck in the worst way imaginable. So forgiving myself, and really coming to terms of what transpired were the hardest, especially when I was mad at God! Your newsletter came at a time where I was not sure what I wanted, even if it meant living.

Back in 2012 I had a psychotic episode, where I took the lives of my only two children, but my three attempts in taking my own life, I still survived, so I was charged for their passing. These next things I write are NOT excuses but merely the facts that led up to that tragic event. I was 24 years old, struggling with mental illness, in an abusive relationship and had earnestly been seeking help. Living in Tucson there were limited resources, especially for a mom with kids and no support. I even sought help from a behavioral health place there in Tucson, where I told them, shortly before this psychotic episode, "I'm hearing and seeing things, I feel like I'm going crazy, something is not right, I need help!" Instead of help I was told I should be put on a rehabilitation plan so I could work on being a better mom, and that I needed to remove the negativity from my life.

My daughter was 4, and my son was 17 months old. I had post-partum depression with anxiety, manic depressive, chronic PTSD, and struggling with a lot more at home, in which the counselor knew. The judge and prosecutors disregarded these facts and instead depicted me as a heartless monster. Being this was my first time ever being in trouble little did I know the public defenders appointed to me would be of no help, even more so being such a high-profile case. At that point, I believed in a thing called 'justice', but it had to take eight painful and hard years for me to realize my Father God did not cause this, nor could He have stopped this, BUT He will make beauty out of my ashes.

Your newsletters were my bit of love and grace. Little by little I started seeing God, going to Him and pouring out my heart to Him. This place (prison) has shown me no mercy, but God does! Not perfect, not completely healed, but gradually He has been restoring my life as painful and heartbreaking as it's been. Again, this is no sob story, no sweet nothings but just my absolute honesty in what took place in my life.

I still struggle with mental illness, among neurological conditions, but my Father is healing me piece by piece. My case is far from over given I'm fighting for a fair sentence given the complexity of my case, but I'm doing this myself. I do ask that you all continue to pray for me, my family, my health and that I am able to find someone who would represent me to fight for what is right. So that I can finally receive treatment here within these walls. Unfortunately there are no resources, programs or classes here to help.

Please continue to pray for these prisons, those of us locked up in them as well as the officers and the staff ... they all are human, too! Thank you for allowing me to share my testimony. God is not done with me yet.
