EQUITATION DIVISIONS

Leadline (1-3): Open to children six (6) years of age or under. To be judged on manners and suitability of mount to rider. Will be asked to trot. No cross-entry. Division will be walk only, Walk-Trot, and Off

Walk/Trot Division (4-6): Open to junior and adult amateur riders on horses and ponies. Riders may not cross enter into any cantering or jumping classes. To consist of one Walk Eq class, one Walk-Trot Eq class, and one Walk-Trot Pleasure class.

Mini Stirrup Division (7-10): Open to riders 10 years of age or under as of the current show year. Rider not to have shown at a canter or over fences 2' or higher at any horse show. Division will be WT, WT Pleasure, WT Figure Eight, WT Poles.

Short Stirrup Equitation Division (11-14): Open to children twelve (12) years of age and under as of the current show year. Rider not to have shown over fences 2' or higher at any horse show.

Beginner Rider Equitation Division (15-18.): Open to riders of any age. Rider not to have shown over fences 2' or higher at any horse show. Division will be WT, WTC, two classes of crossrails.

Novice Equitation Division (19-22): Open to junior and adult amateur riders on horses or ponies. Riders may not have competed at 2'6" or higher. To be judged on hands, seat, and control of mount. Fences 2' or 2'3" at rider's discretion. Division will be WTC class and three O/F.

HUNTER & PLEASURE DIVSIONS

All Hunter Divisions will be three classes Over Fences and one Under Saddle unless otherwise stated.

Pleasure Horse/Pony Division (23-26): Open to all horses and ponies. To be shown in English tack at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. To be judged with emphasis on manners and suitability as well as soundness and performance. No martingales. Classes will be WT, WTC and 4 poles, one over fences not

Short Stirrup Hunter Division (27-30): Open to riders 12 years of age or under as of the current show year. Rider not to have shown over fences 2' or higher at any horse show. Classes will be three classes O/F and one WTC U/S.

Modified Hunter (31-34): Open to all junior and adult amateur riders on horses and ponies. Rider may not have shown higher that 2'3" in any show. May only cross enter into Long Stirrup, Beginner Eq., 2' Equitation or pleasure at the same show. Fences 2'.

Pre-Children's Hunter Division (35-38): Open to junior riders still eligible for Novice Equitation Over Fences at any rated show (have not won three blue ribbons in equitation). Ponies to jump at 2', horses 2'6". May not cross enter into any Children's Hunter class or division on same mount.

Pre-Adult Hunter Division (39-42): Open to adult amateurs on either ponies or horses. Fence heights to be at 2'6". May not cross enter into Adult Amateur Hunter class or division.

Children's/Adult Hunter Division (43-46): Open to horses and ponies ridden by juniors or Adult Amateurs. Small/medium ponies 2', large ponies 2'6" and horses 3'. May not cross enter into any Pre-Children's Hunter class or division, or Pre-Adult Hunter class or division on the same mount.

Low Schooling/Hopeful Hunter (47-50): Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Fences at 2'3".

Schooling Hunter (51-54): Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Fences 2'6" High Schooling/Suitable Hunter (55-58): Open to all riders on horses or ponies. Fences 3'. **TB Hunter Division (59-62):** Open to Thoroughbred horses, with or without registration papers. Fences 2'6"

JUMPER DIVISIONS

The first class of the division will be Table II, Sec. 2(b) The second class of the division will be Table II, Sec. (1)

Champion and Reserve will be awarded to the highest scoring horse in the two classes within the division. Itty Bitty Jumper (64-65): Open to all horses and ponies who, as a horse and rider combination, have not won a lifetime total of \$1000 in jumper classes as of December 1 of the current show year. All classes to be run concurrent with USEF tables. Fences 2'3".

Schooling Jumper (67-68): Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Jumps to be 2'6". **High Schooling Jumper (70-71):** Open to all riders on horses and ponies. Jumps to be 3'. Open Jumper (73-74): Open to all. Section A: Fences 3'6" Section B: 4'.

EQUITATION MEDAL CLASSES

Two tests will be built into the first round, no further testing:

M&S 2'6" Children's Medal - Open to junior riders.

M&S 2'6" Adult Medal/NJHSA - Open to Adult Amateur riders.

M&S Children's Medal - NJHSA - 2' Small/Medium ponies, 2'6" Large ponies, 3' Horses
