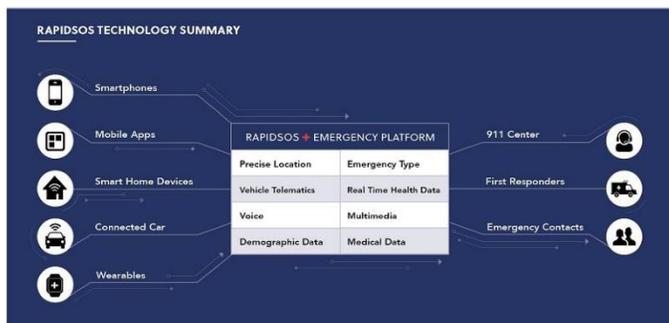




Congressional Panel Cites the Need for 911-Connected Smoke Alarms

On March 29, 2017, the Energy and Commerce Committee of the United States House of Representatives held a hearing entitled *Realizing Next-Generation 911*, discussing the importance of Next-Generation 911 (NG9-1-1) with a panel of experts from government, associations, and industry. Among the topics discussed was the importance of 911-connected Internet of Things (IOT) alarms, and how NG9-1-1 would allow 911-connected smoke alarms, such as the *Nest Protect*, to send direct-to-911 alerts to Public Safety Answering Points (PSAPs). A number of companies are now providing services to connect IoT/M2M devices that send emergency data

alerts directly to PSAPs. Below is a short list of companies that are now offering such solutions, but many others are rapidly creating similar direct-to-911 connected device solutions.

West Safety Services. Their product and services offering is the *9-1-1 of Things*, stating how IOT/M2M technologies are changing how public safety will respond in emergencies.
