MARCH 16, 2023

MINUTES

Denise noted an error in the February 16, 2023 meetings. The organization in Topeka is NOTO. A motion was made by Denise, seconded by Tami to approve the minutes of February 16, 2023 as corrected. The motion was unanimously approved.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Joyce said that she will continue to work on bus tours to come to Garnett to view the galleries, shop and eat locally.

No decision was made on whether or not to have the on line art auction. We will wait to see if we are able to sell art through the Beauchamp Gallery.

We will not have a booth at Square Fair this year as no one is available to be there.

NEW BUSINESS

Discussion was held on the open records request of our 2022 minutes. This request was made by Paula Scott who is a member of the Growing Garnett group. Joyce provided a copy of these minutes to the Garnett City Clerk.

Tami shared information about Anita Pierce and the possibility of her having a display in the west wing gallery. Tami will continue to pursue this.

Discussion was held on asking the junior/senior high school art instructor about having a display of art from her students. Jenelle will talk to Elizabeth to see if this might be possible. If so, it will be done in May and June with Wanda's display moving to July and August.

Jenelle said that she was planning to have a display of her family's art in the fall.

After the business meeting, members prepared the Easter Basket that will be raffled.

Wanda adjourned the meeting at 5:00 p.m.
