## GO WEST YOUNG MAN

When the phrase "go west young man" was popularized in the 1850s it symbolized the American quest to conquer the continent. This belief in a manifest destiny – that the young nation was destined to settle lands from sea to shining sea – became a rallying cry of sorts for pioneers plodding through prairies, across plains, and over mountains. Within three decades, the wild, wild, west was all but tamed.

This college football season is a long way from being settled, but fans looking toward the first college football playoff in just a few months might do well to follow the same directive as those pioneers of yore. Go west, whether within a conference or on an actual map, to find the main contenders for the four playoff spots.

Welcome back to **THE BLITZ**, your source for weekly college football news, information, and statistics ... whatever point of the compass you hail from.

Let's take a look at the college football playoff landscape. The Eastern Seaboard, particularly the northeast where the sport originated, is not even in the national conversation. From Maine to Miami, no contenders appear likely to emerge from the first coast.

In the ACC, the Florida State Seminoles (from the panhandle in western Florida by the way) appear a legitimate threat to reach the playoffs and earn a chance to defend their national title. But, the Noles have not played well. Florida State might be able to sustain one loss and slip into the playoffs, but with a relatively weak schedule, that scenario is risky.

Moving to the SEC, the westward theme stays intact. The Western Division plays each other this week, and the biggest threat to the conference landing a team in the playoffs is the very real possibility that these teams simply devour each other. It is difficult to envision a team getting through this division unscathed. In the SEC Eastern Division no teams look of championship caliber. Georgia is limited at quarterback and in the secondary, South Carolina is flighty, Florida's offense is too pedestrian. So, no SEC Eastern Division team makes the grade.

The Big Ten is much maligned, but should Michigan State, Ohio State, Nebraska, or Wisconsin somehow win out, any might generate some playoff support. The Cornhuskers or the Badgers would have to be the team to keep the westward theme going – so no dice.

As we move toward the left coast, the Big 12 and the Pac-12 have the most direct routes to the championship foursome. Baylor plays at Oklahoma on November 8. Barring an upset along the way, the winner should be playoff bound. The Big 12 has no champion-ship game making its champion's road to the playoff very direct. On the Pacific coast, UCLA travels to Oregon on October 11<sup>th</sup>, and the winner has a leg up in the playoff race.

## AROUND THE NATION

The best weekend of the first half of the season is upon us. Out west, Arizona plays at Oregon in another great Thursday night pairing, while Arizona State heads to Los Angeles to face USC. The bloodletting begins in the SEC Western Division with three terrific games. Alabama visits Ole Miss to see if the Rebels are real contenders. Texas A&M travels to Starkville to play surging Mississippi State. LSU tries to get back into the race on the plains of Auburn. Oklahoma at TCU might be interesting in the Big 12, and Baylor at Texas always packs emotion. In the Big Ten, Nebraska visits Michigan State in a huge conference tilt. Finally, Stanford travels to Notre Dame in a nice intersectional rivalry.

## NEBRASKA AT MICHIGAN STATE



The Nebraska Cornhuskers (5-0) travel to East Lansing to face the Michigan State Spartans (3-1) in a huge primetime, Big Ten showdown that will be nationally televised on ABC at 8:00 PM EDT.

These are two teams that are capable of winning the remaining games left on their schedules, so that just magnifies the importance of this contest for each program.

Spartan QB Connor Cook and Husker RB Ameer Abdullah are far and away the keys in this game. Cook has established himself as one of the premier classic drop back prostyle quarterbacks in college football. He sees the field exceptionally well and makes sound decisions. Abdullah is one of the superior running backs in college football. He runs with power but possesses great speed and an uncanny way to select the correct hole to run through. It will be interesting to see which defense has the most success in this game. Will it be the Husker "D" vs the balanced MSU offense or will it be the Spartan defense vs Ameer Abdullah?

Nebraska leads the all-time series with Michigan State 7-1 but the Spartans came away with a 41-28 victory in Lincoln last year. We believe that this will be a very competitive and evenly matched game and that either team can win, but we're going with the home town Spartans to come away with the victory.

## 2014 NON-CONFERENCE RECORDS (THRU SEPTEMBER 27, 2014)

Below we show the updated non-conference records of all 10 NCAA Division I Football Bowl Subdivision Conferences. We show the conference, the number of teams in each conference during this 2014 season, their record vs non-conference opponents as of September 27, 2014 and their final 2013 non-conference records.

In 2014 The 10 NCAA Division I FBS conferences are playing a total of 105 nonconference games vs NCAA Division I FCS opponents. The break down by conference is as follows. The SEC will play 14 FCS opponents. The ACC:14, MAC:13, Big Ten:11, MWC:10, C-USA:9, American: 9, Sun Belt :9, Big 12: 8, Pac-12: 8.

FYI, there are just 3 FBS schools that have never played a Division IAA/FCS opponent since Division I was sub-divided prior to the 1978 season. Those three schools are Notre Dame, Southern California and UCLA.

# PROGRAM SPOTLIGHT TENNESSEE



When ever someone wants to talk about a great Tennessee head coach they usually end up talking about Robert Neyland and that is a great decision, however, we feel that Phillip Fulmer is one of the greatest coaches in the history of the Southeastern Conference. From 1992-2008 Fulmer led the Vols to a 152-52 record with 5 SEC Eastern Division titles 2 SEC Championships and the 1998 National Championship.

Tennessee has such a long rich football history. They have won 13 SEC Titles and 2 AP National Championships. About the only thing missing from the legacy of Volunteer football is that no player has ever won the Heisman Trophy. Johnny Majors in 1956, Heath Shuler in 1993 and Peyton Manning in 1997 all finished as runner-up. The 1997 Heisman Trophy announcement still ruffles a lot of the Tennessee fans feathers.

The Tennessee football program has just endured 4 consecutive losing seasons. This is something the Vol nation has not gone through since the 1903-1906 seasons but Butch Jones seems to have a good plan to rebuild the Volunteer program and bring them back.
