

IVY SPRINGS POOL & HOT TUB RULES

WARNING: There is NO lifeguard on duty.

- No smoking within the fenced pool area or on the common areas
- No one under the age of 14 is allowed in the pool area without parental or guardian supervision. Supervising adults must be 18 years or older.
- No one under the age of 14 is allowed in the hot tub without parental or guardian supervision. **No one under the age of 5 is allowed in the hot tub, as per state law.**
- Proper swimming attire must be worn in the pool and hot tub. No cutoffs. Children that are not potty trained must be in a swim diaper or vinyl pull-ups over a regular or clothe diaper.
- No food or gum is allowed in the fenced pool area. The pavilion located adjacent to the pool is to be used for this purpose.
- No glass is allowed in the fenced pool area. All beverages must be in a plastic and re-closeable container. If a beverage spills, residents are responsible for clean-up immediately.
- **No alcoholic beverages are allowed in any common areas, as per county law.**
- No animals are allowed in the fenced pool area.
- No running, jumping or diving.
- Music is only allowed with the use of headphones or personal headsets.
- Only floatation devices and toys intended for pool use are allowed, these toys are not allowed in the hot tub. Flotation devices intended for use in rivers and lakes are not allowed in the pool. Management may remove any toys or flotation devices that are being used improperly.
- In times of inclement weather the pool is closed.
- Management reserves the right to ask any resident or guest to leave the pool or hot tub if they are being a nuisance and not obeying the above stated rules.
- Use of recreational facilities is restricted to homeowners and their guests.
Residents must accompany their guests at all times.
- All use will be in accordance with posted rules that may be changed as needed.
- You swim at your own risk. Residents are responsible for any injury incurred while on the premises.
