#### Misleading Finals

-Louisville only had a 410-402 yard edge in a 48-21 win over Wake Forest. The Cardinals were +7 in TO's and out-scored Wake 35-0 in the 3Q.  
-Connecticut upset Boston College 13-3 but the Huskies were out-gained 335-280. UConn was +5 in TO's.  
-Penn St out-gained Ohio St 482-452 but were -4 in TO's in the 44-31 loss.

-Miami, Oh beat Akron 27-9 but were out-gained 396-268. The Redhawks benefited from a +3 TO margin.  
-San Diego St had a 449-391 yard edge vs Fresno St but lost 32-28 as the Aztecs were -3 in TO's. San Diego St led 28-10 late 3Q and Fresno scored a pair of TD's in the final 70 seconds of the game.

#### Bad Beats

-TCU got a 29-yard TD pass on fourth down with :20 left to put the game over the 69.5-point total. It also gave TCU (-7) backers the cover. A double bad beat!  
-Baylor got a 17-yard TD run with :45 left to put the game over the 61-point total. Baylor won 45-17.  
-Wake Forest got a 5-yard TD pass with :14 left to put the game over the 66.5-point total. Louisville had intercepted a pass seconds earlier but fumbled it on the return.

### Games in Rotation Order

#### Wednesday, November 2nd

**NORTHERN ILLINOIS 32 Central Michigan 26.** We're coming off a Tuesday night where both MAC underdogs won outright. CMU actually has the better ypp and ypg margins but NIU has played most of the season with a backup QB. Will NIU QB Rocky Lombardi return again here?

**BOWLING GREEN 27 Western Michigan 25.** A lot of money has come in on the Falcons here. Not sure we agree with the move past a key "3" number. The two teams are pretty even in the stats (WMU -1.2 in ypp, BG -1.1).

#### Thursday, November 3rd

**RICE 27 Utep 24.** Rice comes in the shocking loss to Charlotte last week where they failed to cover the spread by 48 points! Both teams need this one if they have bowl aspirations (both sitting at 4 wins). Lean OVER which is 7-1 in Rice games.  
**Appalachian St 32 COASTAL CAROLINA 29.** If you're wondering why App St is the road favorite and has taken money early in the week, the Mountaineers are +1.6 (No. 12) in yards per play margin. Meanwhile, despite their gaudy 7-1 record, the Chanticleers are only +22 ypg and +0.1 in yards per play margin.

#### Friday, November 4th

**Duke 28 BOSTON COLLEGE 21.** Duke hasn't been a double-digit road favorite in ACC play since 1994! We've upgraded the Blue Devils by 2 TD's since the start of the season and downgraded BC by 12.5 points and we still have a 3-point overlay here. Make sure to check the status of BC QB Phil Jurkovec.

**CONNECTICUT 27 Massachusetts 14.** What a job Jim Mora has done in year one for the Huskies. This is their largest favorite role vs an FBS team since 2012! Their upset over BC was misleading last week (+5 TO's). We lean UMass.

**WASHINGTON 28 Oregon St 24.** If you're wondering why this total has dropped a TD, the National Weather Service is forecasting an atmospheric river to pass through Seattle on Friday with heavy rain and wind. We're staying away.

#### Saturday, November 5th

† **Air Force 23 Army 16.** @Globe Life Field in Arlington, TX. The UNDER has cashed in 8 straight meetings with an average total score of 27 ppg. Since 2005, the UNDER is 42-9-1 in games played between two service academies. Nuff said.

**North Carolina 32 VIRGINIA 24.** The early money is on Virginia and the UNDER. As bad as Virginia has been this year they are still +0.6 in ypp margin (NC +0.8). We bet UNDER 63.5 and UVA +11 and still lean UNDER.

**Michigan 35 RUTGERS 11.** Michigan comes in off the emotional game vs Michigan St both during and after. The Wolverines are dominant in the stats ranking No. 4 in yards per play margin (+2.6), No. 3 in ypg margin (+219.5) and No. 3 in scoring margin (+29.5). However, we think this is a little steep vs a Rutgers defense that ranks No. 12 in ypp and No. 13 in ypp.

**Wake Forest 29 NC STATE 23.** We like Wake here because of last week's disparate result. Wake was outscored 35-0 in the 3Q vs Louisville as the Demon Deacons incredibly had 8 TO's in the second half. They'll rebound here vs an NC State team that will see a true freshman make his first career start.

**Florida St 31 MIAMI 22.** If you're surprised to see the Seminoles No. 16 in our power ratings, don't be. FSU is No. 6 in yards per play margin (+2.2) and No. 7 in ypp margin (+163.6). Miami is -0.1 in ypp (No. 84) despite playing a weaker schedule. Even if Miami QB Tyler Van Dyke returns, we lean with the Noles.

**VIRGINIA TECH 24 Georgia Tech 18.** QB Jeff Sims looks like he will be back for GT here. However, this spread looks a little light with VT having the better ypp, ypg and ppg margins. We like the Hokies here.

**PURDUE 23 Iowa 18.** We bet Iowa +7 on the Sunday openers. Believe it or not the Hawkeyes have the better yards per play margin thanks to a defense that ranks No. 1 in allowing 3.9 yards per play. Note, there could be heavy winds.

**Penn St 33 INDIANA 19.** Obviously, you had to be impressed with Penn St last week vs the Buckeyes as turnovers ultimately did them in. We expect them to rebound here and laid -13 on the Sunday openers thinking it would close -14. Again like much of the midwest, there could be heavy winds in the forecast.

**LOUISVILLE 31 James Madison 24.** The key here is to check the status of James Madison QB Todd Centeio. He miss the Dukes last game and they looked lost without him. The early week line movement indicates he will play. Yes, JMU has played a much weaker schedule, but their stats are impressive ranking No. 7 in ppg margin and No. 5 in ypp margin. Louisville is off a misleading blowout last week (+7 TO's).

**PITTSBURGH 27 Syracuse 24.** Another game with yet another QB injury question mark. Syracuse QB Garrett Shrader was KO'd of last week's loss to Notre Dame. As of press-time his status was uncertain. The Orange are the better team in the stats but after playing NC State, Clemson and ND, they are banged up.

**Oklahoma St 35 KANSAS 31.** Oklahoma St comes in reeling off the 48-0 loss to Kansas St last week. Now they take on a Kansas team that is off a bye and wants to become bowl eligible for the first time in more than a decade. Early money has been on Kansas but we disagree.

**CINCINNATI 34 Navy 13.** Navy QB Tai Lavatai is out for the season. Xavier Arline looks like he will get the start here. They're taking on a Cincinnati defense that is mad off a loss allow just 4.3 yards per play (No. 6). We lean Cincy.

**South Florida 27 TEMPLE 24.** Temple is better in the stats as they are No. 107 in ypp while USF is No. 123. However, USF has played the much tougher schedule (No. 33 vs No. 99 in Sagarin). We did bet Temple +6 on Sunday and anything above "3" is a lean that way.

### HOME TEAM IN CAPS

**Minnesota 30 NEBRASKA 17.** If you're wondering why this line looks so steep, Nebraska will likely be without QB Casey Thompson here and the Huskers looked lost in the second half last week without him. Plus, Minnesota has massive edges in ypp margin (No. 21 vs No. 73), ypg margin (No. 11 vs No. 105) and ppg margins (No. 8 vs No. 96). It's still a lot of points though.

**Marshall 25 OLD DOMINION 22.** Marshall has covered just one game since upsetting Notre Dame earlier this season. On paper, they are clearly superior including a +108.1 ypg margin (No. 24) vs an ODU team that is -83.9 ypg (No. 117). We bet Marshall -1 on the openers but can't lay more than 3.

**ARKANSAS 38 Liberty 24.** It doesn't get much bigger than a No. 14 vs No. 127 strength of schedule disparity this time of year. Both teams easily won and covered vs BYU recently. Liberty is the much better team in the stats but again played a much weaker SOS. While Arkansas games are 7-1 to the OVER, we actually thought this total was priced to high.

**ILLINOIS 29 Michigan St 14.** Michigan St has now suspended eight players due to the altercation in the tunnel after the Michigan game. They include five of the top 13 tacklers. Illinois is No. 8 in ypg margin. Not surprised to see a ton of money on Illinois here but they've been priced out as far as value. Check weather.

**WISCONSIN 28 Maryland 22.** Both teams come in off a bye. It looks like Maryland will see the return of QB Taulia Tagovailoa who missed the last 6 quarters. Maryland is the better team in the stats. We bet OVER on Sunday but it looks like wind will play a big factor. That would impact Maryland more.

**3★ Texas 31 KANSAS ST 26.** We like Texas here. Number one, they are the better team in the stats ranking No. 11 in ypp margin, No. 40 in ypg margin and No. 17 in ppg margin despite playing the No. 10 toughest schedule. The Horns have lost 3 games this season but still rank in the Top 10 of our power ratings as all 3 losses were close. They're off a bye and catch Kansas St off a 48-0 destruction of Oklahoma St so we're selling the Wildcats high.

**OKLAHOMA 31 Baylor 28.** The more we dive into this game the more we lean with Baylor here especially catching "the hook". Baylor is better in ypp, ypg and ppg margins. The only concern is Oklahoma's horrific performances, they were without QB Gabriel and DB Billy Bowman (QB of defense). Both are back.

**Kentucky 22 MISSOURI 20.** The two teams are a combined 14-2 to the UNDER this year and there could be stronger wind in the forecast. We think it could be a "buy low, sell high" spot after last week's disparate performances with Kentucky getting blown out and Missouri pulling the upset. We haven't gotten to the window.

**Ohio St 47 NORTHWESTERN 10.** Even after struggling with Penn St, Ohio St is still No. 1 in ppg margin and yards per play margin. Northwestern ranks No. 118 and No. 117 in those two categories. We understand the huge number here and note there will be more Buckeye fans than Northwestern fans in the stands. Lean UNDER.

**Western Kentucky 42 CHARLOTTE 27.** Charlotte covered a point spread by 48 points last week (beat Rice 56-23 as 15-point dogs) while WKU failed to cover their game by 37 (lost 40-13 as 10-point favorites). That usually would scream value on WKU here but we actually bet Charlotte +18 on the openers and the market agrees.

**Oregon 47 COLORADO 16.** This is the largest away favorite role for Oregon since 2013. It is deserved considering they are a Top 10 team facing a Colorado team that continues to rank dead last in ypp, ypg and ppg. We bet OVER 59.5.

**BOISE ST 30 Byu 23.** Two teams heading in opposite directions. BYU has now failed to cover the spread in 7 straight games by an average of 14.4 ppg. Since changing QB and OC, Boise has covered 4 straight by 11.8 ppg. With that being said, we lean UNDER.

**UTAH 40 Arizona 23.** This line indicates Utah will get back starting QB Cam Rising who was a shocking late scratch in the Washington St game. Utah saw TE Kincaid go down to injury (already lost Kuithe) and their top 2 RB's were banged up. The early forecast is calling for temps in the upper 30's. We lean UNDER.

**SAN JOSE ST 33 Colorado St 12.** We think San Jose St is a little over-priced in the market right now. After 4 straight covers, they've failed to cover the spread by 14 and 17 points in their last two. We lean Colorado St here.

**FRESNO ST 40 Hawaii 16.** Fresno saw the return of QB Jake Haener and many more players last week. The market bet them up to double-digit favorites vs San Diego St only to see them trail 28-10 late 3Q. The Bulldogs rallied for the win and we're wondering if that saved their season. Meanwhile, Hawaii's defense has shown improvement lately. We lean UNDER.

**Washington St 26 STANFORD 22.** If either team has bowl aspirations this season, they need a win here. Washington St's defense is the best unit on the field and a big reason why Wazzu games are 7-1 to the UNDER by 11.4 ppg. Pass.

**USC 40 California 20.** Tough laying more than 3 TD's with a USC defense that ranks No. 88 in ypp allowed and No. 108 in yards per play allowed. Shocking us is a Cal defense that ranks No. 100 in ypp allowed and No. 97 in ypp.

**Middle Tennessee 33 LOUISIANA TECH 30.** It looks like Parker McNeil will be back this week for Louisiana Tech who was down to a 3rd string QB last week in their upset loss at FIU. Middle Tennessee is the better team in the stats.

**Ucla 40 ARIZONA ST 28.** Arizona St has shown some life with their interim coach especially on the offense side with Trenton Bourguet at QB. Meanwhile, UCLA continues to impress ranking No. 8 in ypp margin, No. 14 in ypg margin and No. 16 in ppg margin. We lean UCLA and OVER.

**TEXAS A&M 29 Florida 25.** Texas A&M is on the verge of not making a bowl game. Yikes! Florida showed some fight after trailing UGA big at halftime last week but their defense ranks No. 117 in ypp allowed and No. 112 in ypp allowed. Can A&M take advantage? Probably not. We have no interest.

**Tulane 33 TULSA 27.** Tulane comes in off a bye and the Green Wave are 7-1 ATS this year. They rank a respectable No. 28 in ypp margin, No. 26 in ypg margin and No. 14 in ppg margin and have legit New Year's Six aspirations. We were originally leaning Tulsa but they could be without QB Davis Brin.

**2★ SMU 34 Houston 30.** SMU has played the tougher schedule (No. 48 vs No. 62). SMU is better in ypp margin (No. 51 vs No. 71), better in ypg margin (No. 57 vs No. 69) and better in ppg margin (No. 55 vs No. 72). SMU has allowed late scores vs Navy and Tulsa to make finals look more respectable than what they were. SMU was down to a 3rd string QB last week but get starter Tanner Mordecai back. We think this line closes -4 and 1-point off a key "3" is all we need for a best bet.

**SOUTHERN MISS 27 Georgia St 26.** Check the weather forecast for this one (possible wind and rain). We were a little surprised to see the total bet down to the upper 40's. Georgia St does have the better offense (No. 56 vs No. 112 in ypg).

**South Carolina 30 VANDERBILT 21.** We are a little surprised with this line. We faded South Carolina on these pages last week and turned out to be correct with Missouri beating them outright. However, our ratings like them here. SC has a huge edge in ypp margin (No. 61 vs No. 124).

**MISSISSIPPI ST 33 Auburn 22.** Obviously, the big news here is that Auburn has fired head coach Bryan Harsin. Former Auburn RB Carnell Williams is the interim coach. Interim coaches have fared well this season at 12-9 ATS. In their first game they are 4-2 ATS with the 4 covers all coming by more than 3 TD's per game! Can you say one-game bump?

**GEORGIA 36 Tennessee 27.** Obviously, the game of the year so far in CFB. The Tuesday CFB Playoff rankings has Tennessee No. 1 and Georgia No. 3 but let Vegas help you as Georgia is more than a TD favorite here. The Bulldogs are better in ypp margin (No. 3 vs No. 5), ypg margin (No. 1 +268 vs No. 8 +159) and ppg margin (No. 2 vs No. 4). Tennessee seems like they are going to be that square popular public underdog this week. We recommend waiting if you want to bet Georgia.

**2★ Texas Tech (plus the points) TCU 37 Texas Tech 30.** TCU is the much more explosive team (No. 9 in ypp margin vs TT No. 74). However, the ypg margins are close (TCU No. 21, TT No. 22). TCU has been extremely fortunate including last week's cover vs West Virginia. Meanwhile, Texas Tech's blowout loss to Baylor was misleading (-4 in TO's). That creates value here.

**Central Florida 33 MEMPHIS 27.** A lot of money coming in on Memphis here. The expectation could be that QB John Rhys Plumlee could be out for them. We don't see Mikey Keene as that big of a downgrade. He was the starter last year and helped beat Cincy last week. UCF is better in ypp margin (No. 16 vs No. 69), ypg margin (+158 vs +9) and ppg margin (No. 6 vs No. 65).

**IOWA ST 29 West Virginia 23.** Both teams need a win if either has any bowl aspirations left this season. Iowa St is much better in ypp margin (No. 60 vs No. 105) and ypg margin (No. 36 vs No. 66). We originally bet OVER but weather could be a factor (wind and rain).

**2★ New Mexico (plus the points) UTAH ST 28 New Mexico 15.** Utah St looks like they will get QB Cooper Legas back. However, do you really want to lay this margin with a Utah St team that ranks No. 110 in ypp margin, No. 122 in ppg margin and No. 104 in ypg margin? On top of that, you have massive off-field issues with a lawsuit against the head coach and the athletic director just resigned. "Obviously we're dealing with a tremendous amount of distractions. They're coming from all sides," Utah St State head coach Blake Anderson said in an interview Tuesday.

**Utah 28 UAB 26.** A little luster has been taken off this matchup with UAB's upset loss last week. Will QB Dylan Hopkins return here? UAB statistically the superior team in ypp margin (No. 10 vs No. 64), ypg margin (No. 23 vs No. 41) and ppg margin (No. 30 vs No. 52). However, UTSA is off a bye and has been more consistent.

**Alabama 36 LSU 22.** Another massive game in the SEC. The winner has the inside track on the West Division title. Alabama is the superior team in ypp (No. 2 vs No. 44). LSU QB Jayden Daniels is the type of QB that has given Alabama fits in the past. He has a 12-1 ratio and leads the team in rushing. However, the LSU OL has allowed 26 sacks and will be facing a ferocious Alabama pass rush.

**NORTH TEXAS 41 FIU 20.** Both teams are playing their best ball of the season. North Texas has covered 5 straight games while somehow FIU has 4 wins, which we thought was impossible after the 73-0 loss to WKU. Don't see much value.

**South Alabama 32 GEORGIA SOUTHERN 28.** Two teams that have exceeded expectations so far this season. South Alabama has the edges in ypp (+1.1 vs -0.4), ypg (+126 vs +14) and ppg (+14 vs +6.5). We didn't bet side or total.

**UL-MONROE 27 Texas St 26.** Texas St is the better team in the stats with better ypp margins (No. 99 vs No. 114), ypg margin (No. 95 vs No. 116) and ppg (No. 92 vs No. 126). However, ULM has played the tougher schedule (No. 63 vs No. 95). Another game where we didn't bet side or total.

**SAN DIEGO ST 27 UNLV 22.** The story here is that UNLV off a bye will see the return of QB Doug Brumfield who missed the last 2.5 games. The Rebels, once promising season has taken turn for the worse with 3 straight blowout losses. However, they still have a better ypp margin (No. 78 vs No. 96), a better ypg margin (No. 96 vs No. 107) and better ppg margin (No. 84 vs No. 93). San Diego St is off a misleading loss to Fresno St (see page 1). We bet UNLV +9 and still lean that way.

**3★ Clemson 26 NOTRE DAME 19.** We just don't get the love affair for ND in the market-place for this game. The way to beat Clemson defensively is through the air. We question whether ND can do that. ND QB Drew Pyne in his first 3 starts was 63 of 85 (74%) with an 8-to-1 ratio. In his last 3 starts, he is just 36 of 74 (49%) with a 4-to-2 ratio. Clemson will load up the box to stop the run. On the other side, ND's defense ranks dead last in the country in red zone defense. After being benched, we expect a more motivated DJ Uiagalelei.

## Week 10 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past six seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 421-355-12 (54%) clip! So far this season those games are 28-26-1.** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 6 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Virginia Tech -3.**

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

**Philadelphia 28 HOUSTON 15.** Obviously, you have an 7-0 team in Philly (No. 3 in ypp margin) taking on a 1-win Houston team that is No. 31 in ypp margin. the Texans were dominated more than the final last week getting run over by the Titans as they were at a 314-43 rush yard disadvantage. Meanwhile, Philly was +3.3 in ypp margin in a blowout of Pittsburgh. Not fond of laying 2 TD's on the road on a short week. We'll lean UNDER.

**Sunday, November 6th**

**2★ Indy (plus the points) NEW ENGLAND 22 Indianapolis 19.** New England has been very good to us on these pages this year besides a teaser loser in the Chicago game. However, we're not sure of the 5.5-point spread here. Indy is No. 18 in ypp margin vs the No. 20 schedule. New England is No. 15 in ypp margin vs the No. 25 schedule. Last week Indy gave up a late TD in the loss to Washington while NE was out-played (-2.9 ypp) vs the Jets. We like the Colts here getting a lot of points for such a low total (UNDER is 7-1 in Colts games this year)

**Buffalo 28 N.Y. JETS 17.** Obviously, the Bills are the best team in the NFL with a +1.6 ypp margin vs the No. 3 toughest schedule in the league. They did get back-doored vs the Packers last week as big favorites (led 24-7 at halftime). The Jets have been a surprise and actually rank No. 8 in ypp (+0.6) vs the No. 7 toughest schedule. They had a misleading loss to the Pats last week as they had a 6.7-3.8 ypp edge. That gives us value here.

**Miami 25 CHICAGO 20.** Miami closed on a 24-6 run to get a win and cover (if you bet before gameday) over the Lions last week. The Dolphins are No. 9 in ypp margin vs the No. 5 toughest schedule. Meanwhile, Chicago was exposed in Dallas with a -2.6 ypp deficit. Early week money is on Miami. We don't see much value.

**Minnesota 23 WASHINGTON 20.** It still amazes us that Minnesota sits here at 6-1 straight up vs the No. 31 schedule and is -0.5 in ypp margin. That continues to make them overrated in our opinion. Washington is -0.6 in ypp margin but has played the No. 17 schedule and has pulled back-to-back outright upset wins with Heinicke at QB. We lean with Washington here.

**1★ Green Bay 28 DETROIT 23.** Are we finally at the ultimate "buy low" spot for the Packers? They've now lost 4 straight games but did get the back-door cover by a hook last week in Buffalo. Detroit raced out to a 14-point lead only to lose by 4 to the Dolphins. The Packers are -0.1 in ypp margin vs the No. 13 schedule while Detroit is -0.3 vs the No. 10 schedule. Rodgers should have himself one of his best performances of the season vs the Lions No. 32 defense.

**2★ L.A. Chargers 27 ATLANTA 21.** We think this is a nice spot for the Chargers off a bye after suffering a loss to the Seahawks. They catch an Atlanta team off an OT win but the Falcons failed to cover for the 2nd straight week (started 6-0 ATS). People will talk about the "Hail Mary" for Carolina but the Panthers probably should have won outright considering they had a 4th Down failure, missed PAT, missed 32-yard FG and Atlanta got an interception return TD. Atlanta is No. 29 in ypp margin. That means they're fortunate to be sitting at 4-4 on the season.

### HOME TEAM IN CAPS

**CINCINNATI 26 Carolina 17.** Cincinnati comes in off the blow-out loss to the Browns on MNF. The Bengals are still No. 15 in ypp margin and that broke their 5-game ATS win streak. We expect them to bounce back vs a Carolina team off an OT loss to Atlanta. At 2-6, does reality start settling in for them with an interim coach and a backup QB? We lean with Cincy -7.5 but prefer to tease the Bengals down to -1.5.

**Las Vegas 25 JACKSONVILLE 23.** The Raiders come in off the embarrassing 24-0 loss to the Saints last week. We expect them to bounce back here. Meanwhile, Jacksonville has failed to cover the spread in 5 straight games by an average of 7 points per game. Remarkably, they still rank in the Top 10 in ypp margin. It's a tale as old as time that we hear every week... "the sharps are on the Jags." Yet, they continue to come up short every week at the window. If you want to bet Jacksonville, we'd recommend them in a teaser up through "3 and 7".

**Seattle 26 ARIZONA 25.** You have to be impressed with the Seahawks. They've won and covered 3 straight games and are in first place of what was thought to be a loaded NFC West. It's not fluky either as they rank No. 9 in ypp margin while the Cardinals rank No. 30 in ypp margin. A few weeks ago, the Seahawks won outright vs the Cardinals and we wouldn't be surprised if they did again.

**TAMPA BAY 22 L.A Rams 20.** It's yet another week where we are seeing money come in on Tampa Bay. It's ridiculous at this point considering the Bucs have failed to cover six straight games by an average of 11.4 ppg. You think they'd hit a "buy low" spot but the market continues to bet them as a favorite each week and you're still paying premiums. They flipped to favorite last Thursday vs Baltimore and lost outright. The Rams don't inspire a lot of confidence at No. 26 in ypp margin and were -3.1 ypp last week vs the 49ers. We prefer to tease the Rams here up through 3 and 7.

**KANSAS CITY 27 Tennessee 17.** As of press-time we're not quite sure who will play QB for the Titans. The 12.5-point line seems to indicate we're getting Malik Willis especially considering the Titans have won and covered 5 straight games. They are a bit "fool's gold" at No. 26 in ypp margin. Meanwhile, Kansas City is off a bye and the Chiefs are No. 4 in ypp margin vs the No. 1 toughest schedule. Obviously, they are the far superior team but we think this line is steep.

**Monday, November 7th**

**Baltimore 25 NEW ORLEANS 23.** Both teams got big wins last week. Baltimore does have extra time to prep after the Thursday Night upset of the Bucs. Meanwhile, New Orleans dominated Las Vegas winning the yardage 367-183 and the ypp 5.8-3.3. Tough game. We think the line is about right and would prefer to tease the Saints up through the important 3 and 7 numbers.
