- PRIMROSE, yellow



- CORAL BELLS, green leaves, partial sun

- MILKWEED for Monarch butterflies, sun



- HOSTA, part sun, shade
- SUNFLOWER, small yellow flowers on tall stems
- MUMS, cranberry, orange, sun
- BLACK-EYED SUSAN, sun



- PEONY light pink



- BEE BALM, red



- LILY of the VALLEY, partial sun to shade



- DIANTHUS Cheddar Pinks, sun
- GERANIUM, Scented
- SEDUM, ground cover, pink flowers, sun to shade
- BETHLEHEM STAR bulbs, small white flowers, short
- GOOSE NECKS, partial sun



PERENNIAL SHRUBS:

- GOAT'S BEARD, 12-72", white plumes, shrub-like in summer, sun to shade
- HUMMINGBIRD VINE, up to 15', slow climber, orange flowers, sun to partial shade
- ROSA RUGOSA, hot pink flowers, sun to partial shade
- SPIREA, to 48" high, 36" wide, dusty to deep rose flowers, sun to part sun
- LILAC, sun



- * FORSYTHIA, yellow flowers, sun



FRUIT/VEG:

- MINT apple version
- ONION white
- RASPBERRY, thornless to 5', yield summer thru fall, tasty, sun to part sun
- CHIVES
- RHUBARB
